Schedule I, Part I, Line 2 (Supplemental Information continued) Each year, the NPH homes submit their budgets to the NPHI Finance Committee for recommendation and to the NPHI Board of Directors for review and approval. Friends is represented on the NPHI Board of Directors through the CEO who the Friends Board of Directors elected to serve. Upon approval by the NPHI Board of Directors, the budget is submitted to the Friends Board which reviews it and determines how much budget support it is able to commit for the upcoming year. Once the year begins, the budgets are monitored monthly by the NPHI Finance Committee of which the Friends CEO and CFO are members. In addition, the Friends Board regularly reviews and approves out-of-budget special and capital project requests approved and monitored under the auspices of the NPHI Executive Committee. Upon approval, Friends may solicit, receive and send funds for these projects. Each year the homes submit independent audits which are received and reviewed by the Friends CFO and Treasurer. The NPHI CEO serves as a member of Friends Board of Directors and provides a report on the activities of NPHI at each quarterly meeting of the Friends Board of Directors. Friends recruits, screens and places volunteers in the NPH homes for a minimum of one year of service. In addition, Friends staff escort donor and school trips to the Homes periodically throughout the year. In all cases, they are instructed to inform the Friends CEO of any unusual or disconcerting situations observed. Finally, many members of Friends of Board of Directors and staff attend the NPHI Annual meeting held at one of the NPHI homes and have an opportunity to see one of the homes and spend time with the children and staff at the home.
