## ANNOUNCEMENT OF GRANTS FOR 2010 (Release date 30 October 2009)

#### The PYAR Foundation is pleased to announce the availability of grants for 2010.

Deadline for proposal submission is:

Proposals arriving after the deadline will be considered in the next funding cycle.

#### What is PYAR and what are its Funding Priorities?

PYAR is a small, non-profit (US-IRS 501(c).3), Private, charitable Foundation whose primary mission is to promote the welfare and well-being of children in distress across the world, with special emphasis on the welfare of orphans and children from dysfunctional or broken families, or children disadvantaged by whatever special causes. Support for adults may be considered if this will indirectly help the cause of their children.

<u>Priority 1</u> in funding will be given to projects aimed at alleviation of suffering of children, especially orphans and children displaced from their natural families.

<u>Priority 2</u> in funding will be given to projects aimed at promoting the balanced physical, social, personal, intellectual, language and spiritual development of children with special needs. This may include remedial programs.

<u>Priority 3</u>: PYAR will also consider supporting programs in which the welfare of children may be promoted indirectly, say, through support of adults on whom children may be dependent. PYAR will also consider supporting educational programs for children, and parenting programs.

<u>Priority 4.</u> Finally, PYAR will also consider supporting programs of humanitarian assistance to adults in dire need.

Because of the limited amount of available funding, top priority will be given to projects which can alleviate suffering or begin to promote development immediately, rather than programs which may, very commendably, aim at addressing issues in a more longer-term approach. Hopefully, PYAR will grow to support those kinds of programs also, in the future.

#### **Typical Annual Funding Levels**

New projects: Normally up to US\$2000 Continuing projects: Normal max. US\$1500

#### **Proposal Requirements**

Proposals will be entertained from formally-registered non-profit and religious organizations only; the latter must not include in PYAR projects any activity related to proselytization. Proposals must be received, by email (gillani9999@gmail.com), by 30 November 2009, and signed copies (required) by mail, to reach the PYAR address (see below), no later than 15 December 2009. Proposals must be signed by responsible officials of the organization. No funding in excess of \$500 will normally be granted without a proposal submission. Electronic proposals will be accepted from overseas organizations by the deadline, but will be funded only if signed proposals are also received by mail by December 15. Proposals received at mid-year will be considered and funded in mid-year if they are especially deserving and if funds are available. If funds are not available then, they will be retained for consideration at the end of that year.

The proposal itself must be limited to 2 pages in the form of a WORD file. Supporting materials (e.g., organizational brochures, etc.) may be included as Appendices. For first-time funding from PYAR, the nature and function of your organization must be briefly described. For all applicants, the specific project for which the funding is requested must be described very clearly, with clear delineation of the beneficiaries (qualitatively and quantitatively), the nature of services to be delivered and benefits expected to be derived, the qualifications of the organization for the work, and the total budget of the project, including amount requested from PYAR. For continuation funding (normal max. \$1500), the proposal need not include information about your organization, except for significant changes, but the specific project to be funded, and the budgetary information, must be included.

PYAR will not support any political activities or projects, including the work of advocacy groups. The projects must be of a purely humanitarian nature.

Successful projects will be funded for a period of up to one year, starting on or after January 1, 2010. Continuation funding beyond 2010 may be possible, based on available funds and future proposal submissions. PYAR expects to grow and make more funding available in the future.

A brief electronic progress report (~ 1 page) and financial report (~ 1 page) of the funded project (in the form of WORD file) will be required and due by June 30, and a Final Report will be due by November 30 during the Project year. Reports must be in English. Photograph depictions of the project activities are particularly encouraged. PYAR may also contact the funded organizations at any time during the project for information related to project progress. Informal ongoing progress sharing by email is highly encouraged. Dr. Gillani will be the PYAR Project Officer for all projects. Either Dr. Gillani, or a formally designated PYAR representative, may wish to make a site visit during the project period. Such visits and on-going project monitoring must be welcomed and assisted.
