# UNITED REGIONAL HEALTH CARE SYSTEM AUXILIARY CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS

#### ARTICLE I NAME

#### Section I

The name of this organization shall be the United Regional Health Care System Auxiliary.

#### ARTICLE II PURPOSES

#### Section I

The purposes of this organization shall be as follows:

- 1. To aid the hospital in various ways to provide better or more care for the patients through direct or indirect financial assistance.
- 2. To provide and encourage supplement patient services both inside and outside the hospital.
- 3. To increase the community's understanding of United Regional Health Care System.

#### Section II

The Auxiliary recognizes that the Corporate Board of United Regional Health Care System is the governing body of United Regional. Any activities undertaken by the Auxiliary must be within the framework of the policies established by said Board. In order that the Auxiliary may serve the hospital effectively, it will work under the general direction of the hospital administrator.

#### ARTICLE III MEMBERSHIP

#### Section I

Anyone who is interested in the purposes of this auxiliary may become a **member**, by paying dues of one dollar or more per year. The amount is to be decided by the individual. Any member may indicate the extent of participation in auxiliary work which he/she wishes to give during the year, or he/she may choose to support the auxiliary through dues only.

#### Section II

Junior auxiliary members are classified as associate members of the auxiliary.

#### ARTICLE IV BOARD OF DIRECTORS

#### Section I

The board of directors for the auxiliary shall consist of twelve members elected annually. The board of directors shall be composed of the president, first vice president, second vice president, treasurer, recording secretary, corresponding secretary, historian, immediate past president and four additional directors elected from the membership. The hospital administrator or his/her representative shall be an ex-officio member of the board of directors.

#### Section II

Members of the board of directors shall be elected at the annual election of officers.

#### Section III

The board of directors shall interpret the constitution and by-laws and define auxiliary policy.

#### Section IV

Meetings of the board of directors may be called by the president or any two directors.

#### Section V

The duties of the board of directors shall be as follows:

- 1. To carry on the business of the auxiliary between regular meetings.
- 2. To make recommendations to the membership.
- 3. To make plans for the development of the auxiliary and the execution of its purposes.
- 4. To appoint officers to fill vacancies if they occur.
- 5. To consider the formation of adjunct services and make recommendations to the membership.
- 6. To study and make recommendations to the membership on any project submitted to it by the membership or the president.
- 7. To establish or discontinue standing committees.

#### ARTICLE V OFFICERS

#### Section I

The officers of this organization will serve as the executive board and shall be as follows:

President
First Vice President
Second Vice President
Treasurer
Recording Secretary
Corresponding Secretary
Historian

#### Section II

Officers shall take office on the first of May. The term of office shall be for the coming year.

#### Section III

An officer may be elected for additional consecutive years in the same office when approved by the Board of Directors. The Board recommends Officers and Board members serve a maximum two consecutive one year terms in the same office.

#### Section IV

The duties of the president shall be as follows:

- 1. To preside at regular and special meetings.
- 2. To preside at meetings of the executive board.
- 3. To serve as chairman of the board of directors.
- 4. To appoint chairman of special committees.
- 4. To appoint chairman of special committees.
- 5. To call executive or board of directors meetings.
- 6. To call special meetings of the auxiliary.
- 7. To provide leadership for the auxiliary.
- 8. To be an Ex-Officio member of the United Regional Foundation Board.

The duties of the first vice president shall be as follows:

- 1. To assume the duties of the president in case of absence.
- 2. To serve as chairman of the membership drive.
- 3. To serve as a member of the executive board and of the board of directors.

The duties of the second vice president shall be as follows:

1. To assume the responsibilities of the president as indicated

- 2. To serve as chairman of luncheon programs and the Recognition Coffee
- 3. To serve as a member of the executive board and of the board of directors.

The duties of the treasurer shall be as follows:

- 1. To receive and disburse auxiliary funds in accordance with the action of the auxiliary.
- 2. To keep records of the money received and disbursements and report to the Membership
- 3. To serve as a member of the executive board and of the board of directors.

The duties of the recording secretary shall be as follows:

- 1. To keep the minutes and other records of auxiliary meetings, regular and special.
- 2. To serve as a member of the executive board and of the board of directors.
- 3. To serve as secretary at meetings of the executive board or board of directors.

The duties of the corresponding secretary shall be as follows:

- 1. To handle correspondence as indicated.
- 2. To serve as a member of the executive board and of the board of directors.

The duties of the historian shall be as follows:

- 1. To keep an accurate record in the form of a scrapbook of the activities of the auxiliary on a yearly basis.
- 3. To serve as a member of the executive board and of the board of directors.

#### ARTICLE VI MEETINGS

#### Section I

Regular meetings shall be held the second Tuesday of the month, **September** through **May** with the exception of January, unless otherwise decided by the executive board.

#### Section II

Special meetings may be called at the request of the president, or of three board members, or of two board members and ten members.

Notification of the membership is to be as similar to the method used for notifying members of regular meeting as is feasible. Advance notification to the office of the hospital administrator is to be made.

Action taken at special meetings is subject to policies clearly defined by the auxiliary. Expenditure of funds must have the approval of the hospital administrator or his representative. Contractual agreements made at a special meeting must have the approval of the executive board.

#### ARTICLE VII VOLUNTEER SERVICE

#### Section I

Members who elect to work in volunteer service within the hospital must meet the qualifications of the hospital. Because volunteers represent both the auxiliary and the hospital in their contacts with others, they must be carefully selected.

#### Section II

It shall be the joint responsibility of the Volunteer Services Coordinator and the hospital administrative representative to develop and coordinate the operational procedure for volunteer workers.

#### ARTICLE VIII ESTABLISHMENT AND DISCONTINUANCE OF COMMITTEES

#### Section I

Committees shall each have three or more members and be of one of the following types:

A committee can be established by the membership, the president, or the executive board, and will function for the specific purpose for which they were named. Chairmen of committees shall be named by the president with the recommendation of the Coordinator of Volunteer Services.

The president shall be an ex-officio member of each committee except the nominating committee.

#### ARTICLE IX COMMITTEES

#### Section I

It shall be the duty of the nominating committee to submit one name for each elective office and the four members-at-large. Permission must be received from each nominee before their name is submitted. The names shall be presented to the membership at the **February meeting and elected in March**.

It shall be the duty of the nominating committee to give careful consideration to the selection of nominees for the various offices.

#### Section II

The president, with the recommendation of the coordinator of volunteer services, shall appoint a committee of 3-5 members to form the gift shops committee.

Duties of the gift shops committee shall be as follows:

- 1. To purchase all merchandise for the gift shops.
- 2. To price all merchandise for the gift shops.
- 3. To promote sales through special events and displays.

Upon recommendation of the Coordinator of Volunteer Services and Gift Shop Manager and approval of Board of Directors, changes may be made to the Gift Shop Committee.

#### Section III

The president, with the recommendation of the coordinator of volunteer services, shall appoint the advisors of junior auxiliary groups.

#### ARTICLE X QUORUM

#### Section I

Two officers and five members shall constitute a quorum at any regular or special meeting of the auxiliary.

#### Section II

Five members of the executive board shall constitute a quorum at any meeting of the board.

#### ARTICLE XI VOTING

Each member present shall have one vote at all regular or special meetings with the exception of junior auxiliary members.

#### ARTICLE XII ELECTIONS

#### Section I

The election of officers and board members shall be held at the **March** meeting of the auxiliary after being presented to the membership at the **February** meeting.

#### Section II

After presenting the report of the nominating committee, the president shall call for nominations from the floor. After the nominations are closed, the voting shall be by secret ballot unless there is only one nominee for each office.

#### ARTICLE XIII BUSINESS YEAR

The business year of the auxiliary shall commence on January 1 and shall end on December 31.

#### ARTICLE XIV FUNDS

Section I

Auxiliary funds must be used only for the benefit of the United Regional Health Care System. No auxiliary member or members of the family of an auxiliary member may receive grants from the auxiliary funds.

Section II

Books must be kept on all auxiliary funds and these books must be open for inspection by auxiliary members. Books shall be available for audit by an independent accounting counsel as directed by the executive board. Coordinator of Volunteer Services with Board of Director approval will hire an accounting firm for oversee of financial records of the Gift Shop.

Section III

If the auxiliary should dissolve, United Regional Health Care System will receive all assets and all liabilities.

#### ARTICLE XV PARLIAMENTARY AUTHORITY

The <u>Roberts Rules of Order</u>, newly revised, shall be considered as the guide for procedure not otherwise covered in this constitution and these by-laws.

#### ARTICLE XVI AMENDMENTS

Section I

Amendments to this constitution and by-laws may be made as follows:

The proposed amendment may be submitted to the membership by the executive board at any regular meeting. Notification of consideration of amendments to this constitution and by-laws shall be included in the next regular meeting notification. At the first regular meeting following notification, approval by two thirds of the members present and voting shall constitute passage of the amendment.

## Section II

Amendments shall go into effect immediately after passage unless they concern changes in the purposes of the auxiliary or changes in the use of its funds, in which approval by the Administrator/CEO shall be required before said amendments become effective.
