List Enhancement Project: Montana Conservation Voters Education Fund combines the membership lists of the state's conservation and environmental groups and supportive allies with socio economic and demographic data, and returns this "enhanced" data to the groups. MCVEF also coordinates a statewide data base of conservation and environmental group members to be used on collaborative mailings, phone calling and educational programs. MCVEF upgraded its list project through help from the League of Conservation Voters Education Fund by appending additional demographic information on its members, and by adding email addresses. MCVEF was also offered the opportunity to provide a training document to LCVEF for use by its sister state groups. In 2010, 23 groups took part in the List Enhancement Project, and 17 list uses were coordinated by MCVEF at the request of participating groups, reaching over 49,500 citizens.
