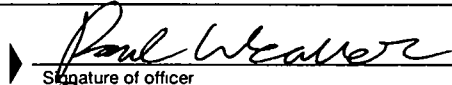

The Lincoln Community Center has operated as a non profit 501 (C) 3 since 1999, the organization has always been a small local community based non profit in Laramie Wyoming. The organization has never received large contributions in its years of operation and was ran by an all volunteer grass roots board of directors with no employees. Recent changes in the law have created a new environment that the Lincoln Community Center is working hard to adapt to and it is making good progress. However, the center has not reported through the required methods for a few years. The organization is currently in the process of catching up with correct reporting and has filed for notice 2011-43 transitional relief. The Lincoln Community Center has had limited financial activity over the last few years and is undergoing a renovation using funding from the State of Wyoming that is controlled completely by Albany County in the state of Wyoming. This has halted regular fund raising activity and instead refocused the organization toward generating match funding in the county. This required match funding is almost the entirety of the revenue generated for the Lincoln Community Center in 2010. This money must be turned into the Albany County Treasurer's Office. These funds are then used to match the funds granted through the State of Wyoming these dollars are not used for any purpose other than the renovation of the Lincoln Community Center Building which will be completed in December of 2011. The building itself is owned by Albany County for the next 5 years under the Wyoming Business Council grant agreement. Some funds have been generated through rent from various clubs using the space provided by the Lincoln Community Center in 2010 these are reported in the 990-EZ paper work.
