The High School program was established to impart a basic knowledge of financial planning covering the fundamentals of money management, insurance, investments, tax planning, retirement planning, and estate planning. The program focuses on youth and was introduced in 1984. The program consists of course materials for students and teachers which are distributed in partnership with the USDA Cooperative State Research, Education, and Extension Service and Participating Land-Grant University Co-op Extension Services. The materials are provided free of charge to public and private high schools and vocational schools throughout the country. This program has been taught to students in more than 12,000 schools in all 50 states.

NEFE introduced the web-based CashCourse program in 2007. CashCourse was developed as a financial education resource for College students and has been deployed to over 250 institutions.
