A Special Meeting of the Board of Directors of the ISLAND FOUNDATION was held by a telephone conference on the date and time indicated above. It is noted that all the directors were notified of the time of the meeting and the topics to be discussed, by an e-mail, sent to them by President Walter Sedgwick. It is noted that Sally Ranney has submitted a letter of resignation effective December 23, 2010.

The two members present represent two of the three seats, a majority, on the Board of Directors. The following items of business were discussed:

Amendment of the bylaws was discussed, wherein the number of directors would be changed from three directors to one or more directors, up to three, and the following resolution was unanimously approved:

RESOLVED: that the BYLAWS, ARTICLE II, BOARD OF DIRECTORS, # 2. NUMBER TENURE AND QUALIFICATIONS is hereby amended to read: The number of directors of the corporation shall consist of one or more directors, up to three.

The resignation of Ms. Sally Ranney is hereby accepted.

ADDITIONAL BUSINESS:

The chairman noted that over the course of the last several years the Foundation has held many formal and informal meetings of its directors, both annual and special meetings, however, at times no formal minutes were recorded for many of these meetings and at other times minutes were taken which have since been misplaced. However, all financial transactions have been recorded as is reflected in the yearly filed tax returns.

The Chair raised the question of whether the Board of Directors should approve the prior recorded or unrecorded actions of the officers and directors. After a discussion, the following resolution was offered, seconded and unanimously adopted:

RESOLVED: That any and all actions taken or contracts entered into heretofore by any officer or director for the Corporation, either as an officer or director, as well as any and all actions taken or contracts entered into by said persons as individuals, acting for the Corporation, be and the same are hereby ratified, approved and confirmed by the Corporation, and all such contracts adopted as though said individual had at such time full power and authority to act for and by the Corporation and in the same manner as if each and every act had been done pursuant to the specific authorization of the Corporation.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, the same was, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously approved, adjourned.

BYLAWS

OF

ISLAND FOUNDATION

ARTICLE I

OFFICES

The principal office of the corporation in the State of Colorado shall be located in the City and County of Denver, State of Colorado. The corporation may have such other offices, either within or without the State of incorporation as the Board of Directors may designate or as the business of the corporation may from time to time require.

ARTICLE II

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

1. GENERAL POWERS.

The business and affairs of the corporation shall be managed by its Board of Directors. The directors shall in all cases act as a board, and they may adopt such rules and regulations for the conduct of their meetings and the management of the corporation, as they may deem proper, not inconsistent with these Bylaws and the laws of this State.

2. NUMBER, TENURE AND QUALIFICATIONS.

The number of directors of the corporation shall be three. Each director shall hold office until the next annual meeting of the Board of Directors and until his successor shall have been elected and qualified.

3. MEETINGS AND NOTICE.

The regular meeting of the Board of Directors shall be held without notice.

The directors may provide, by resolution, the time and place for the holding of additional regular meetings without other notice than such resolution. Special meetings of the Board of Directors may be held at anytime or place within or

without the State of Colorado whenever called by the President, Secretary, or any two directors, with notice thereof being given to each director as herein provided. Notice of special meetings may be oral or written but must reach each director not later than 48 hours before the time at which the meeting is to be held. Special meetings may be held at any time without formal notice provided all the directors are present or those not present shall at any time waive or have waived notice thereof.

4. QUORUM.

At any meeting of the directors, two shall consitute a quorum for the transaction of business, but if less than said number is present at a meeting, a majority of the directors present may adjourn the meeting from time to time without further notice.

5. MANNER OF ACTING.

The act of the majority of the directors present at a meeting at which a quorum is present shall be the act of the directors.

6. NEWLY CREATED DIRECTORSHIPS AND VACANCIES.

Newly created directorships resulting from an increase in the number of directors and vacancies occurring in the Board for any reason except the removal of directors without cause may be filled by a vote of a majority of the directors then in office, although less than a quorum exists. Vacancies occurring by reason of the removal of directors without cause shall be filled by vote of the remaining directors. A director elected to fill a vacancy caused by resignation, death or removal shall be elected to hold office for the unexpired term of his predecessor.

7. RESIGNATION.

A director may resign at any time by giving written notice to the board, the President or the Secretary of the corporation. Unless otherwise specified in the notice, the resignation shall take effect upon receipt thereof by the board or such officer, and the acceptance of the resignation shall not be necessary to make it effective.

8. COMPENSATION.

No compensation shall be paid to directors, as such, for their services, but by resolution of the board a fixed sum and expenses for actual attendance at each regular or special meeting of the board may be authorized. Nothing herein contained shall be construed to preclude any director from serving the corporation in any other capacity and receiving compensation therefor.

9. PRESUMPTION OF ASSENT.

A director of the corporation who is present at a meeting of the directors at which action on any corporate matter is taken unless his dissent shall be entered in the minutes of the meeting or unless he shall file his written dissent to such action with the person acting as the Secretary of the meeting before the adjournment thereof or shall forward such dissent by registered mail to the Secretary of the corporation immediately after the adjournment of the meeting. Such right to dissent shall not apply to a director who voted in favor of such action.

10. EXECUTIVE AND OTHER COMMITTEES.

The board, by resolution, may designate from among its members an executive committee and other committees, each consisting of two or more directors. Each such committee shall serve at the pleasure of the board.

ARTICLE III

OFFICERS

1. NUMBER.

The officers of the corporation shall be a President, a Vice-President, a Secretary and a Treasurer, each of whom shall be elected by the directors. Such other officers and assistant officers as may be deemed necessary may be elected or appointed by the directors.

2. LLECTION AND TERM OF OFFICE.

The officers of the corporation to be elected by the directors shall be elected annually at the first meeting of the directors. Each officer shall hold office until his successor shall have been duly elected and shall have qualified or until his death or until he shall resign or shall have been removed in the manner hereinafter provided.

3. REMOVAL.

Any officer or agent elected or appointed by the directors may be removed by the directors whenever in their judgment the best interest of the corporation would be served thereby, but such removal shall be without prejudice to the contract rights,

if any, of the person so removed.

4. VACANCIES.

A vacancy in any office because of death, resignation, removal, disqualification or otherwise, may be filled by the directors for the unexpired portion of the term.

5. PRESIDENT.

The President shall be the principal executive officer of the corporation and, subject to the control of the directors, shall in general supervise and control all of the business and affairs of the corporation. He shall, when present, preside at all meetings of the directors. He may sign, with the Secretary or any other proper officer of the corporation thereunto, authorized by the directors, any debts, mortgages, bonds, contracts, or other instruments which the directors have authorized to be executed, except in cases where the signing and execution thereof shall be expressly delegated by the directors or by these bylaws to some other officer or agent of the corporation, or shall be required by law to be otherwise signed or executed, and in general shall perform all duties incident to the office of President and such other duties as may be prescribed by the directors from time to time, expressly including the signing of checks upon the corporate bank account.

6. VICE-PRESIDENT.

In the absence of the President or in the event of his death, inability or refusal to act, the Vice-President shall perform the duties of the President, and when so acting, shall have all the powers of and be subject to all the restrictions upon the President. The Vice-President shall perform such other duties as from time to time may be assigned by the President or by the directors.

7. SECRETARY.

The Secretary shall keep the minutes of the directors' meetings in one or more books provided for that purpose, see that all notices are duly given in accordance with the provisions of these bylaws or as required, be custodian of the corporate records and of the seal of the corporation, and in general perform all duties incident to the office of Secretary and such other duties as from time to time may be assigned by the President or by the directors. If absent from any meeting, an assistant Secretary or a Secretary pro tempore shall perform the Secretary's duties thereat.

8. TREASURER.

If required by the directors, the Treasurer shall give a bond for the faithful discharge of his duties in such sum and with such surety or sureties as the directors shall determine. He shall have charge and custody of and be responsible for all funds and securities of the corporation; receive and give receipts for monies due and payable to the corporation from any source whatsoever, and deposit all such monies in the name of the corporation in such banks, trust companies or other depositories as shall be selected in accordance with these bylaws and in general perform all of the duties incident to the office of Treasurer and such other duties as from time to time may be assigned by the President or by the directors.

9. SALARIES.

The salaries of the officers shall be fixed from time to time by the directors and no officer shall be prevented from receiving such salary by reason of the fact that he is also a director of the corporation.

ARTICLE IV

CONTRACTS, LOANS, CHECKS AND DEPOSITS

1. CONTRACTS.

The directors may authorize any officer or officers, agent or agents, to enter into any contract or execute any instrument in the name of and on behalf of the corporation, and such authority may be general or confined to specific instances.

2. LOANS.

No loans shall be contracted on behalf of the corporation and no evidences of indebtedness shall be issued in its name unless authorized by a resolution of the directors. Such authority may be general or confined to specific instances.

3. CHECKS, DRAFTS, ETC.

All checks, drafts or other orders for the payment of money, notes or other evidences of indebtedness issued in the name of the corporation, shall be signed by such officer or officers, agent or agents of the corporation and in such manner as shall from time to time be determined by resolution of the directors.

4. DEPOSITS.

All funds of the corporation not otherwise employed shall be deposited from time to time to the credit of the corporation in such banks, trust companies or other depositories as the directors may select.

ARTICLE V

FISCAL YEAR

The fiscal year of the corporation shall be such year as shall be established by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE VI

SEAL

The directors shall provide a corporate seal which shall be circular in forma and shall have inscribed thereon the name of the corporation, the State of incorporation, year of incorporation and the words, "Not For Profit Corporation".

ARTICLE VII

WAIVER OF NOTICE

Unless otherwise provided by law, whenever any notice is required to be given to any director of the corporation under the provisions of these Bylaws or under the provisions of the Articles of Incorporation, a waiver thereof in writing, signed by the person or persons entitled to such notice, whether before or after the time stated therein, shall be deemed equivalent to the giving of such notice.

ARTICLE VIII

ADMENDMENTS

These bylaws may be altered, amended or repealed and new Bylaws adopted as provided by the Colorado Corporation Code at Colo. Rev. Stat. 7-5-108 (1973).

ARTICLE IX

MEMBERS

This corporation will have no members.
