An experience that can be shared

Triathlon is an individual sport. But through the Janus Charity Challenge family members, friends and colleagues can participate in their athletes' triathlon journey. The fundraising finish line for each race is midnight before race day. Preliminary awards will be announced at each race Awards Ceremony. A final announcement of fundraising awards will be made following Janus' nonprofit verification process.

Requirements for Janus Charity Challenge Athletes

It is MANDATORY to read the program requirements below prior to registering:

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Complete race registration. Participating athletes must be registered for and race in one of the following Life Time Race to the Toyota Cup Triathlons in 2011: CapTex Triathlon in Austin, TX, Life Time Minneapolis Triathlon, Life Time Chicago Triathlon, Kaiser Permanente Los Angeles Triathlon and Toyota US Open in Dallas, TX. Race entries are not provided through this program. (Miami will be included in the 2012 program; Philadelphia is not included, as they host a separate charity program.) Athletes entered in any distance race, including relay participants, may join the Janus Charity Challenge program.

Confirm 501(c)(3) designation. The charity must hold tax-exempt non-profit status under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue code at the time of registration for the JCC. A copy of the charity's tax exemption letter must be faxed (303-336-4630) or emailed (januscharitychallenge@janus.com) to the JCC organizers prior to registering for the JCC. Please include the athlete's name and race when sending this documentation.

Verify no strings attached. The athlete may not be employed by the charity for which funds are being raised.

Fundraise the right way. An athlete may begin fundraising only AFTER they have an official entry into one of the participating LTF races. Funds may be raised through pledges, fundraising events (pre-existing fundraising events cannot be used for the purposes of the JCC) or personal donations. Athletes may use the assistance of other people in collecting/raising funds for their charity; however, all funds must be collected expressly for the Janus Charity Challenge.

Set up Blackbaud site. Be sure to create a fundraising website that is personal and compelling. Utilize pictures and specific stories to create a connection between potential donors and your efforts.

Manage your account. Once registration is complete, athletes can return to their site to manage their fundraising, update personal and charity information, run fundraising reports and track their fundraising success through the Participant Headquarters (found under the Fundraising Tools Tab)

Collect and track donations. Janus does not collect any money for the Janus Charity Challenge. All checks must be made out to the charity. The athlete is responsible for sending offline donations (cash, checks or credit card donations made directly to your charity) to his/her charity within two weeks following the race. All donations made offline (cash and checks) must be tracked using the athlete's Blackbaud Participant Headquarters, our official athlete donation tracking system.

Additional Information

- Blackbaud will withhold \$1.76 per transaction for processing plus 2.59% in credit card processing fees from all donations made online. Online donations, less the Blackbaud transaction and processing fees, are considered tax deductible contributions.
- Donations made online via credit card (less administrative fees) will be sent directly to the charities within two to three weeks following each race. Only those donations that have been raised and collected midnight the day before the athlete's race will be considered for the purposes of identifying the top fundraisers in the Janus Charity Challenge.
- Approximately three weeks following the race, a Janus representative will verify receipt of all contributions directly with each charity. If a charity does not respond to our request for verification by the deadline, they will become ineligible to receive a Janus donation.
- If the amount actually received by the charity is lower than the amount listed on your Blackbaud Participant Headquarters site, this could alter the standing of the top fundraisers and affect the level of additional funds that your charity is eligible to receive.
- The athlete is responsible for providing correct and UPDATED contact information for the charity. This can be done through your Blackbaud Participant Headquarters site.
- The series top fundraisers will be announced at the Dallas race, via email and on the Janus Charity Challenge website.

Athlete Registration

To sign up for the Janus Charity Challenge, simply complete the **athlete registration form**. From this page, athletes will be directed to the Blackbaud Participant Headquarters, the official fundraising management system for the Janus Charity Challenge. From here, a personal fundraising page is created to help participants easily manage and track their fundraising progress. Note that athletes can accept cash, checks or credit card donations made directly to the charity, but must track and record all donations through their Participant Headquarters to qualify for the program.

Participating athletes must be registered for and race in one of the following Life Time *Race to the Toyota Cup* triathlons in 2011: CapTex Triathlon in Austin, TX, Life Time Minneapolis Triathlon, Life Time Chicago Triathlon, Kaiser Permanente Los Angeles Triathlon and Toyota US Open in Dallas, TX (The Nautica South Beach Triathlon in Miami will be included in 2012. The Philadelphia Insurance Triathlon hosts a separate charity challenge program. Please go to the race website to learn more.) Race entries are not provided through this website.

Step By Step Registration Process:

Step 1:

If you have not done so, register for your Life Time *Race To The Toyota Cup* Triathlon.

Step 2:

Fax a copy of the charity's IRS 501(c)(3) determination letter to the Janus Charity Challenge at 303-336-4630, or email a PDF to januscharitychallenge@janus.com. All charities must have confirmed 501(c)(3) status (not pending) to be eligible for this program and this paperwork must be received before registering on line and prior to beginning your fundraising. Failure to submit the proper paperwork may result in the deletion of your fundraising site.

Step 3:

Register for the Janus Charity Challenge by selecting the link for the Lifetime Fitness race you are participating in, below. This will take you to the registration page. Do not try to register through an existing Blackbaud account.

Step 4:

Confirm you have read, understand and will adhere to all Janus Charity Challenge requirements.

Step 5:

Enter your personal contact information followed by your charity's information. You will need:

- Charity name, address, phone and fax number
- Primary contact person and email address
- Federal tax ID number

Create your username and password to complete the set up of your own Blackbaud Participant Headquarter and fundraising page.

DO NOT ENTER ANY OF YOUR PERSONAL INFO IN PLACE OF THE CHARITY'S CONTACT INFO.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

*** If any of your charity's contact information should change prior to the race, it is imperative that you update your Blackbaud Participant Headquarters with this information to ensure that your donations get sent to the appropriate place. Also, if your personal contact information should change, please do the same.

Creating Your Fundraising Page:

Creating a personal fundraising page allows you to differentiate yourself and your charity. It's also a venue for you to tell a

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compelling story that will inspire people to give. Sharing photos, personal experiences and connections with your charity can help. Once your fundraising page is set up, you can make edits and update your account as often as you like by logging in to your Blackbaud Participant Headquarters.

The cutoff for fundraising is midnight the day before the athlete's race. Athletes will continue to have access to their account for seven days following the race, at which point it will be closed. The top fundraisers will be announced at the ceremony following each race, as well as communicated via email and posted on the Janus Charity Challenge website the week following each race. The series awards will be announced in Dallas and also via email and on the JCC website.

You are not required to take online donations, but you must track all offline contributions by entering them through your Blackbaud Participant Headquarters. Any offline donations that are not recorded in Blackbaud will not be counted toward your total. Sorry, but no exceptions.
