# THE MARSON FOUNDATION

#### STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

The Marson Foundation is a Colorado non-profit corporation which uses its revenues to support humanitarian projects and to address humanitarian needs in the local Colorado Springs community.

It is a private foundation within the meaning of the Internal Revenue Code 509(a), and is an organization described under the Internal Revenue Code as a 501(c)(3) organization. Accordingly, it is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, scientific, educational, and other purposes.

The Marson Foundation welcomes applications for specific programs located in the Pikes Peak area (El Paso and Teller Counties).

The Foundation's interest in funding programs and projects precludes grants for general operating budgets.

Applications not complying with this Statement of Purpose and Guidelines to the Application for Grants will not be considered.

# GUIDELINES TO APPLICATIONS FOR GRANTS as of February 1, 2002

The Marson Foundation has no formal grant application forms. However, if your organization would like to apply to The Marson Foundation for a grant, please submit a document which includes the following information:

- 1. Name and address of tax exempt organization.
- 2. A brief history of the organization, its mission, principal programs and accomplishments.
- 3. A concise statement of the purpose of the request and the amount requested. Outline the need for the project, the specific solutions to be reached, the expected contributions to the population served, and the criteria for measuring the success of the project.
- 4. Budget projections for the current year and for the proposed term of the grant. Please include the total amount to be raised and a list of expected sources of funds for this project, and indicate how the organization plans to fund this project when The Marson Foundation funding ceases.
- 5. Applicants should furnish:
  - a. Relationship and capacity of person signing application;
  - b. A list of members of the governing body;

- c. A statement that notes the grant purpose has been approved by the applicant's governing body;
- d. A photocopy of the organization's current tax exempt 501(c)(3) letter;
- e. A photocopy of the organization's classification under Section 509(a) of the Code;
- 6. Because The Marson Foundation has limited resources to distribute in support of many worthy proposals, it is most interested in using its grants to support initiatives that enable agencies or organizations to start or extend programs and services that would otherwise not be provided. The Marson Foundation recognizes that its grants are not sufficient to sustain many of these programs and services but trusts that timely support of worthy proposals is essential to encourage vision and initiative.
- 7. The Marson Foundation expects that recipients of grants will execute plans and assess success. Of course not every initiative works out as well as hoped; however, for those that do work, it is expected that the agency or organization will find ways to continue, develop and refine initiated programs and service. The Marson Foundation would not normally provide support for the maintenance beyond a period of initial development.
- 8. The Marson Foundation has no objections to its name being included in your organization's published list of benefactors. Please do not use The Foundation's name in any other material without its consent. The Marson Foundation requests that you not use the name of either the Foundation Officers or the Directors in any publications or public discussions, without the Foundation's approval.
- 9. Recipients of a grant are to provide the Foundation's Board of Directors a written evaluation of its activities, specifically, how the organization utilized the grant to have an impact on the community. These reports and evaluations are to be received by The Foundation prior to February 1 of the year following the year in which the grant was received.
- 10. Proposals may be submitted at any time; however, as grants will be distributed during the month of May, applications should be received by The Foundation prior to April 1 of the year for which the grant is requested.
