Program Service Accomplishments

The mission of Grand Canyon Youth, Inc. (GCY) is to provide youth an experiential education along the rivers and in the canyons of the Southwest in an effort to promote personal growth, environmental awareness, community involvement and teamwork among people of diverse backgrounds. Our programs are for youth ages 11-19. GCY celebrated its 12th year of service in 2010.

The educational philosophy of GCY is to inspire curiosity about place, community and self. The focus of the trips is not only in the educational curriculum but in the teachable moments along the river, where learning is not an abstract concept but something real and hands-on for students.

The Grand Canyon Youth program season runs from March through August. During that period in 2010 we facilitated 26 river education programs serving over 400 participants from across the country and internationally on 2,815 participant days. GCY provided the majority of the equipment, food, guides, transportation and educational support for these immersion-type programs from our warehouse and office based in Flagstaff, Arizona. In addition, GCY facilitates three service-learning clubs at local schools where students assist in the planning, implementation and reflection on service projects throughout the year.

Whitewater rafting is a pastime that is enjoyed primarily by those who have the financial means and interest to participate. At Grand Canyon Youth we believe that *everyone*, regardless of background can benefit from time on the river and time away from the bustle of society. We strive to serve youth from a variety of socioeconomic and cultural backgrounds and continue to seek more ways to bridge this gap of service. Our scholarship program allows many students who don't have the financial means to earn their trip through additional community service hours instead of through their bank accounts.

In 2010, Grand Canyon Youth awarded a record amount of scholarships totaling more than \$30,000. Above the number of scholarships we awarded, our programs continue to be one of the most affordable programs of its kind in the region. (River trips similar to ours normally cost from \$184 per day for the San Juan and \$382 per day for the Grand Canyon; our participants pay approximately \$100 per day, not including scholarship awards.)

Community Service and Education

As part of the Grand Canyon Youth program, youth engage in community service, including over 5,000 hours in 2010. They are also required to earn a portion of the cost of their trip, and

research and present an educational project of their choice related to the cultural or natural history of the Southwest. For example, students who choose a geology project will first study a geological map of the area, but then experience firsthand the immensity in size and scope of the rock layers they have only learned about in a book. While on the river, youth participate in every aspect of the trip, - rigging the boats, cooking, pumping water, hiking and paddling downstream. Many of the programs have an arts (writing, painting) or science theme (geology, flora, fauna, ecology). Several trips each year address special populations such as Native American youth or youth with physical or mental disabilities.

The list of powerful, life-changing stories is long: GCY alumni who are now studying geology and wildlife biology at universities because they were inspired on a GCY trip; students who had never slept under the stars or had never experienced the Milky Way; students who taught adults they encountered on river about endangered fish by proudly showing them the science projects they were pursuing. Many of our participants return in following years to experience the program again or to continue volunteering with GCY.

Partnerships

GCY is extremely proud of the many partnerships it has forged. Our "Partners in Science" program is a partnership with Grand Canyon National Park and the U.S. Geological Survey which connects youth with on-going professional science projects and working scientists while on the rim or river, such as surveying and invasive species monitoring and removal. Art-centered programs include the "Grand Inspiration," a pilot program in 2010, where youth create art while on the river and then put together an art exhibit for the visitors at the Grand Canyon and in Flagstaff. Additionally, we have the "Native American Youth Artist" program where acclaimed Navajo artist Baje Whitehorne accompanies the trip and leads the students in daily workshops. GCY works with many school and community groups as well as other non-profit organizations, including the Grand Canyon Trust, which has a long history of community and environmental service. Our program differs from the other river programs in our area because students are required to earn their participation and we provide outreach to underserved populations.

Currently, our Partners in Science programs are flourishing on the Colorado River through Grand Canyon National Park. We are very proud of this model of inspiring students to be "stewards instead of tourists" through science service-learning work. There are other river sections on the San Juan River in Southeastern Utah and on the lower Colorado River that are in great need of service work. We have expanded our program to extend our successful program model to these other sections of the river through collaboration and partnerships. Additionally, we have extended our service-learning clubs to four Flagstaff high schools which connect young people to learn more about their communities and participate in meaningful service projects.

Program Highlights in 2010

 2010 marks our twelfth year of providing experiential education for young people on the rivers and canyons of the Southwest. Through the years we have nurtured an extensive GCY family that includes alumni, educators, scientists, guides, parent and community volunteers, board members and donors.

- We hired our first full-time Americorps member. The person who held this position helped to facilitate our school-based clubs and orchestrated some of our summer programs. Overall they were an incredible asset to our program at a significantly reduced cost to the organization.
- Youth participants worked along scientists on the Colorado River to collect some of the first data about the tamarisk beetle in the area.
- We celebrated a third year of a river program that brings together low-income youth from Philadelphia with youth from Flagstaff.
- Our organization created and distributed the first annual "Confluence Award" which is given to an individual who has made a positive difference in the Colorado River watershed. It is given to someone who demonstrates a commitment to education, conservation and service. The 2010 honoree was Tamara Naumann, principal botanist and coordinator for Dinosaur National Monument.
- According to our program evaluations:
 - o 100% of parents and participants felt that safety needs were met.
 - o 100% of parents and participants would recommend GCY to others.
 - o 97% of participants felt that they learned something about the cultural and natural history of the Colorado Plateau while on their trip.
 - o 100% of parents felt that GCY provided their son/daughter with an educational experience and believed that the community service was a valuable part of the program.
