November 10, 2010

The Annual Meeting and a Board of Directors Meeting of the Keller Foundation, an Oregon nonprofit corporation (the "Foundation"), was held on Wednesday, November 10, 2010 at 888 SW Fifth Avenue, Suite 1500, Portland, Oregon at 8:30 a.m., pursuant to notice to all Directors. Directors in attendance were: Peter F. Bechen, Brian G. Booth, Charles A. Keller, R. B. Keller, Richard B. Keller II, and Elizabeth K. McCaslin. Also in attendance were: Gary W. Stachlowski, Ruth E. Keller, Vice President and Director Emeritus; Kevin C. Kuch, Executive Director and Carol J. Frohoff, Secretary.

R. B. Keller called the meeting to order, and welcomed the Directors and Officers.

The minutes of the November 12, 2009 meeting of the Foundation were approved in the form provided to the Board.

It was moved, seconded and unanimously approved to adopt the following Resolutions:

RESOLVED, that Article III, Section 2(a) of the Second Restated Bylaws of the Foundation shall be amended to provide for up to seven directors by changing the first sentence of Section 2(a) to read as follows:

The Board of Directors shall consist of at least three directors and may consist of as many as seven directors."

RESOLVED, that Article III, Section 2(h) of the Second Restated Bylaws of the Foundation shall be amended by the addition of two new paragraphs to read as follows:

"KELLER FAMILY MEMBERS shall not be compensated for their services as directors unless authorized in an amount determined by the Board of Directors in its discretion, but only after the Foundation's year-end assets exceed \$20 million.

Total compensation for all directors shall not be allowed to exceed one-half of one percent of the Foundation's total assets in any year."

RESOLVED, that effective November 10, 2010 Gary W. Stachlowski shall be elected a Class B Director of the Foundation to serve in accordance with the Second Restated Bylaws of the Foundation.

Mr. Charles A. Keller inquired if Keller Family Member Directors would have the option to opt out of being paid if they preferred, and it was confirmed that this was possible.
