Our trained staff and area physicians provide in-hospital patient care as well as a wide variety of outpatient and community services. 2010 Highlights. In the fall of 2010, the Foundation launched the Julie Beliel Cancer Screening Voucher Program. This groundbreaking program gives underinsured and uninsured people access to free or low-cost screenings for breast, cervical, prostate, colorectal and other cancers. These screenings are vital to prevention and early detection, and also equip patients and physicians with valuable information for making treatment decisions. The program provides educational and outreach services focused on the importance of early screening and works closely with each patient's primary care physician to ensure the best care available. The Foundation raised more than \$110,000 to support this program at the Hearts of Gold Benefit Luncheon and Gala in November 2010. The Foundation partnered with Gorge Grown Food Network and Hood River County School District to launch the pilot Healthier Communities Project at Hood River Middle School. More than 20 Gorge-area students participated during the year Through hands-on activities, the students learned about the important connections between food, environment, ecology and the community.

	Hood River County Health Department to support a program for pregnant women and their newborn children Health Department Program CAWEM Plus (Citizen/Alien Waived Emergency Medical) is a program through the Hood River County in partnership with the State of Oregon's Department of Medical Assistance Programs to increase health care services for pregnant women CAWEM Plus covers medical, dental, mental health and chemical dependency services. The Foundation underwrote the expense of Hood River County at the request of Providence Hood River Memorial Hospital. This provides insurance coverage for patient who would otherwise be uninsured and often not seek medical care or until extreme risk of health was imminent. This sponsorship of this CAWEM program has resulted in the return of over \$752,000 in payments from CAWEM (Oregon Health Plan) to Providence Hood River Memorial Hospital, La Clinica del Carino, Columb Gorge Family Medicine and other providers in the Gorge. Most importantly, it provided dignity and compassion for families who otherwise might not have sought medical care.

Of note was a drop in dental surgeries from eight each week to five every other week. In fact, the coalition has seen such a decrease in dental cases that the vouchers are now available not only to children, but also to young adults ages 18 to 25 and senior citizens. The dental services will expand to Klickitat, Skamania and Wasco counties in Washington in 2011. Funding for this important community program is provided by the foundation.
