Funding of operational expenses of Providence Hood River Memorial Hospital MissionProvidence Hood River Memorial Hospital Foundation is a non-profit corporation, dedicated to enhancing quality health care at Providence Hood River and the Gorge communities it serves, through philanthropy HistoryProvidence Hood River Memorial Hospital is a true community hospital offering quality health and wellness services to residents and visitors alike Our trained staff and area physicians provide in-hospital patient care as well as a wide variety of outpatient and community services 2010 Highlights In the fall of 2010, the Foundation launched the Julie Beliel Cancer Screening Voucher Program This groundbreaking program gives underinsured and uninsured people access to free or low-cost screenings for breast, cervical, prostate, colorectal and other cancers These screenings are vital to prevention and early detection, and also equip patients and physicians with valuable information for making treatment decisions The program provides educational and outreach services focused on the importance of early screening and works closely with each patient's primary care physician to ensure the best care available The Foundation raised more than \$110,000 to support this program at the Hearts of Gold Benefit Luncheon and Gala in November 2010 The Foundation partnered with Gorge Grown Food Network and Hood River County School District to launch the pilot Healthier Communities Project at Hood River Middle School More than 20 Gorge-area students participated during the year Through hands-on activities, the students learned about the important connections between food, environment, ecology and the community

Hood River County Health Department to support a program for pregnant women and their newborn children Health Department Program CAWEM Plus (Citizen/Alien Waived Emergency Medical) is a program through the Hood River County in partnership with the State of Oregon's Department of Medical Assistance Programs to increase health care services for pregnant women CAWEM Plus covers medical, dental, mental health and chemical dependency services The Foundation underwrote the expense of Hood River County at the request of Providence Hood River Memorial Hospital This provides insurance coverage for patients who would otherwise be uninsured and often not seek medical care or until extreme risk of health was imminent This sponsorship of this CAWEM program has resulted in the return of over \$752,000 in payments from CAWEM (Oregon Health Plan) to Providence Hood River Memorial Hospital, La Clinica del Carino, Columbia Gorge Family Medicine and other providers in the Gorge Most importantly, it provided dignity and compassion for families who otherwise might not have sought medical care

Providence is one of the larger health systems in the country, and as such, the Board benchmarks executive compensation against other large, not-for-profit health systems whose revenue is similar to that of Providence. Base salaries for Providence executives are set at the median level of the market, as identified by the independent consultant and reviewed with the Human Resources Committee.</p> <p>Performance incentives allow executives to earn additional compensation if they achieve specific organizational and individual goals for furthering Providence operating principles - advancing the Providence Mission and core values, meeting benchmarks for charity care, achieving quality targets, delivering top-rated customer satisfaction, meeting employee satisfaction goals and reaching financial performance objectives. The Board of Directors conducts a thorough process to ensure performance incentives are aligned with appropriate practices for not-for-profit health care systems. The Board's process for executive compensation fully complies with IRS standards and mirrors the best practices recommended in the "Report to Congress and the Nonprofit Sector on Governance, Transparency, and Accountability" submitted to the Senate Finance Committee by the Panel on the Nonprofit Sector. The Foundation Executive Director is compensated by a related organization which uses a market based compensation program utilizing several independent third party compensation market surveys to establish pay ranges for the position. The related organization then establishes the individual rate of pay within the range based on relevant experience, skills and competencies. The rate offered to the Executive Director at the time of hire was determined through discussion between the Regional CEO, Regional Director of HR and the Administrative Director of HR. The ranges and rate of pay are reviewed on an annual basis by Regional HR.</p> |
