a. Provide dental care to those in need anywhere in the world, while proclaiming the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

b. To provide economic aid to those in need anywhere in the world, while proclaiming the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

The Amigo Foundation's goals are particularly directed to Central and South America and other parts of the world similarly situated economically.

2. There are two permissible areas for grants by the Amigo Foundation which are as follows:

a. To accomplish the relief of poverty or human distress, including, but not limited to, the provision of food, clothing, or other provisions to indigents or residents, disaster area, or geographical area subject to poverty.

b. To encourage the recipient in the further development of a specialized skill, expertise, or

involvement in a particular discipline or substantive area such as dental or medical services, missionary, and/or evangelistic efforts.
