Louisiana Children's Medical Center (LCMC) is a 509(a)(3) organization, and it supports Touro Infirmary and Childrens Hospital. LCMC's financial statements are consolidated with CH and TI, who both have calendar year end financial statements and file Form 990 with calendar year ends.

LCMC was incorporated on July 13, 2009, in the state of Louisiana, and provides management services and support to Touro Infirmary and Childrens Hospital.

When 990-EZ was prepared for the first year, LCMC filed as fiscal year and cash basis taxpayer. At the time it was prepared there had been no activity for this entity on a cash method. The initial return reflected no income or expenses and no assets or liabilities on the balance sheet. However, as LCMC became operational it became more apparent that its financial reporting should have been on the calendar year basis in order to be in sync with the two hospitals.
