SCHOLARSHIP FUND

The Nor'wood Foundation Scholarship (200.) will be awarded to a worthy Colorado High School graduate who has been accepted to pursue a course of study or instruction at an accredited college or university granting undergraduate or graduate degrees, or at any institution to improve or enhance a literary, artistic, musical, scientific, teaching (or other similar capacity) skill, or talent of the grantee.

Applications will be reviewed by a committee of three persons: one member from the Foundation's Board and two members selected from the faculties of either the Colorado College, the University of Colorado, Colorado Springs, or School Districts in the Pikes Peak region. This committee will select as the recipient a student who has demonstrated an ability to excel in one or more academic disciplines and who has the potential for substantial additional achievement in the years ahead.

This year, available funds will provide a scholarship of \$. The recipien
will be eligible to receive a like sum each year (up to a maximum of four y	ears) that he o
she remains a student in good standing at a college, university or other institut	tion.
Applications must be received by the Foundation on or before. 200. The application package will consist of the following:	

- 1. Complete transcript of the student's academic record in high school;
