The NRWA National Board of Directors has established the Joe & Jean Palmer Endowment Fund to honor the memory of a rural water leader and true friend. This scholarship will benefit the children of the rural water family attending institutions of higher learning

A retired civil engineer and avid environmentalist, Palmer was a prominent figure in the local, state and national water industry. Although he was retired, he was a partner in Stevenson and Palmer Engineering and had held the post of president and CEO. He was co-founder of the Georgia Rural Water Association, serving as president of the organization for four years. He was president of National Rural Water Association from 1994 to 1996 and was named the 1991 NRWA Man of the Year. In recognition of his lobbying efforts as a member of the Water Industry Coordinating Committee, he was invited to the White House to witness the signing of the 1996 Safe Drinking Water Act.

From 1942 to 1969, he was in the U S Army, serving in World War II, Korea, and Vietnam He was chosen as one of the military escorts for President John F Kennedy's funeral cortege and was a member of President Lyndon B Johnson's inaugural committee. Before he retired as a colonel, his last assignment was to the office of Joint Chiefs of Staff in the Pentagon. He received the Silver Star, two Legion of Merit awards, The Bronze Star, the Air Medal, the Joint Staff Commendation Medal and 12 other service medals.

A former science and chemistry teacher, Mrs. Palmer later owned and operated a gift shop and established an insurance agency, winning a number of awards from the insurance industry. Most recently, she had embarked on a successful career in real estate and investment counseling. The Palmers were killed in a traffic accident on May 8, 2000, in their hometown of Camilla, Georgia.

By resolution, the NRWA Rally 2000 in Washington D C was dedicated to the Palmers "They were the epitome of Rural America". Their character, ethics, and morals contributed to the success of their personal businesses as well as the success of rural water nationwide. Rural Water has lost a catalyst, a champion, a leader, and a friend. Their importance and contributions to the rural water family will be felt for generations to come."

#### **Official Rules**

- 1. This endowment scholarship will be made to a student to defray the cost of tuition, books, and/or room and board at an accredited institution of higher learning-approved by the National Rural Water Association (NRWA) through the completion of their degree, not to exceed four years.
- 2. Disbursement of the money will be made each semester upon presentation of recipient's college or university invoice as proof of full-time enrollment, for the first semester.
- 3. Each semester following, recipient must provide proof of full-time enrollment, letter of good standing from the university or college they are attending and a current official transcript.
- 4. The student must maintain at least a 2.5 grade point average in order to retain the scholarship.

- 5. The scholarship money will be paid directly to the student each semester upon proof that qualifications have been met.
- 6. The scholarship will be awarded to children or stepchildren of NRWA or State Affiliate employees; student must be 26 yrs old or under by September 1 of that school year.
- 7. In order to be eligible for a scholarship, applicants must complete this form in it's entirety by answering all questions and submitting all required paper work. This application form must be typewritten, hand written applications will be disqualified.
- 8. If an item in not applicable, please place an N/A in the blank.
- 9. Upon completion return it to the NRWA Scholarship Committee by the entry deadline, February 1, 2009.
- 10. All applications will be first screened on the basis of leadership responsibilities in community and school activities as well as grade point average.
- 11. The scholarship recipient will be selected on the basis of the number, length of commitment, and quality of leadership responsibilities in community and school activities, awards, honors, academic record, career goals, and financial need.
- 12. Applicants will be evaluated on a comparative basis at the sole discretion of the committee.
- 13. Decisions will be final.
- 14. Application material and decisions of the committee shall be confidential.
- 15. Acceptance of scholarship constitutes permission to use recipients name and/or likeness for purpose of promotion.
- 16. Should the parent of the scholarship award recipient leave the employment of the affiliate state association or NRWA for any reason, the student will no longer qualify for the award.
