The following Articles of the Articles of Incorporation of United Way of Ionia County (ID Number 728391) are hereby amended and restated as follows

Article I The name of the corporation is United Way of Montcalm-Ionia Counties

Article II The corporation was incorporated under the provisions of Act No 327 of the Public Acts of 1931, as amended, and the corporation does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit, incidental or otherwise. The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code") (or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code)

Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the purpose of the corporation is

(a) to represent and serve the overall interests of the citizens of Montcalm and Ionia Counties in matters concerning individual and community health and social well being, including but not limited to (i) the funding and coordination of health and human services to the residents of Montcalm and Ionia Counties, (ii) developing teamwork among the social agencies serving Montcalm and Ionia Counties and their constituents, and (iii) the effective planning and execution of the social service programs of such communities, and

(b) to do all things which may be necessary, appropriate or convenient to the achievement of the foregoing purposes and which may lawfully be done by a nonprofit corporation under and pursuant to the laws of the State of Michigan and which are not otherwise prohibited by its Articles of Incorporation or bylaws

Article III The location of the registered office is 594 Covered Village, Belding, MI 48809

Article IX

A No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article II. Except as may be permitted under the provisions of Section 501(h) of the Code (or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code), no substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not

carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Code (or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code), or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under sections 170, 2055 or 2522 of the Code (or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code) These Articles of Incorporation shall not be altered or amended in derogation of the provisions of this Article IX

- B In the event of the dissolution of the corporation, all of the corporation's assets, real and personal, shall be distributed to one or more organizations that are exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code (or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code) and, to the extent possible, with a similar purpose or to the federal government or to a state or local government for a public purpose Any such assets not so disposed of, for whatever reason, shall be disposed of by the order of the circuit court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes Upon the sale of substantially all of the assets or the dissolution of the corporation, surplus shall not be utilized for the private interest of any person
- C In the event the corporation is, or in the future may become, a "private foundation" within the meaning of Section 509 of the Code (or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code)
 - a The corporation shall distribute its income for each taxable year at such time and in such manner as not to be subject to the tax on undistributed income imposed by Section 4942 of the Code (or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code)
 - b The corporation shall not engage in any act of self-dealing as defined in Section 4941(d) of the Code (or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code)
