BUT, THESE REPRESENTATIVES WOULD NOT HAVE VOTING PRIVILEGES ON MATTERS BROUGHT BEFORE THE ASSOCIATION.

-ASSOCIATE MEMBERS INCLUDE HEALTH CLINICS OR INDIVIDUAL PROFESSIONALS
ENGAGED OR INTERESTED IN PRIMARY HEALTH CARE. ASSOCIATE MEMBERS OR
REPRESENTATIVES OF THESE ORGANIZATIONS ARE INVITED TO ATTEND AND
PARTICIPATE IN ALL MEETINGS OF THE ASSOCIATION, BUT THESE REPRESENTATIVES
WOULD NOT HAVE VOTING PRIVILEGES ON MATTERS BROUGHT BEFORE THE

EACH MEMBER SHALL SUBMIT TO THE SECRETARY THE NAME AND MAILING ADDRESS OF THE REPRESENTATIVE ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31 OF EACH YEAR.




