## NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS AS OF AND FOR THE YEARS ENDED MARCH 31, 2011 AND 2010

---

### 1. ORGANIZATION AND SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

**Organization** — McKesson Foundation Inc. (the “Foundation”) is a private not-for-profit organization which provides financial support for charitable, educational, and scientific activities.

**Basis of Presentation** — The accompanying financial statements have been prepared in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America (GAAP) and are presented on the basis of unrestricted, temporarily restricted, and permanently restricted net assets. The Foundation had no temporarily or permanently restricted net assets as of March 31, 2011 and 2010.

**Cash and Cash Equivalents** — Cash and cash equivalents include cash on hand and all highly liquid investments with a maturity of three months or less at the date of acquisition.

**Revenue and Expense Recognition** — Contributions received are recognized as revenue when received or unconditionally promised, and grants made are recognized as expense when made or unconditionally promised. At March 31, 2011, grants payable in less than one year were \$807,718.

**Contributions of Service** — Contributions of service are recognized when they are received if the services (a) create or enhance nonfinancial assets or (b) require specialized skills, and are provided by individuals possessing those skills, and would typically need to be purchased if not donated. Such contributions are comprised of professional and administrative services. The estimated fair value of these contributed services was approximately \$322,000 and \$147,000 for the years ended March 31, 2011 and 2010, and are reflected in the accompanying Statements of Activities and Changes in Net Assets as Other Contributions - unrestricted. These services were contributed by McKesson Corporation (“McKesson”), a related party.

**Concentration of Credit Risk** — Financial instruments which potentially subject the Foundation to credit risk include cash, cash equivalents, and investments. Cash, cash equivalents, and investments are maintained at major financial institutions. The Foundation manages credit risk by establishing minimum credit standards for financial institutions and limiting the amount of credit exposure with any one institution.

**Risks and Uncertainties** — The Foundation invests in various securities including mutual funds. Investment securities, in general, are exposed to various risks, such as interest rate risk, credit risk, and overall market volatility. Due to the level of risk associated with certain investment securities, it is reasonably possible that changes in the values of investment securities will occur in the near term and that such changes could materially affect the amounts reported in the financial statements.

**Use of Estimates** — The preparation of financial statements in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America requires management to make estimates and assumptions. These estimates and assumptions affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities and disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities at the date of the financial statements and the reported amounts of revenues and expenses during the reporting period. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

## 2. INVESTMENTS

The Foundation's investment policy is set by the Board of Directors. SunTrust Bank acts as Trustee for the Foundation's investment portfolio and executes all transactions. SunTrust Bank also acts as portfolio manager, operating within investment guidelines in accordance with the investment policy approved by the Board of Directors. The investment guidelines define a long-term percentage target mix of asset classes.

All donations to the Foundation are recorded at fair value on the date of donation. All investments are carried at fair value based on quoted market prices. Unrealized gains or losses (differences between adjusted cost basis and current fair value) are recognized in the statements of activities and changes in net assets. Realized gains or losses resulting from sales or maturities are recorded on an adjusted cost basis. Adjusted cost represents the fair value of the security at the beginning of the year, or the cost if purchased during the year. Dividend and interest income is recorded when earned.

## 3. FAIR VALUE MEASUREMENT

The Foundation follows Financial Accounting Standards Board (FASB) Accounting Standard Codification ("ASC") 820, *Fair Value Measurements and Disclosures*, for all financial assets and financial liabilities that are recognized or disclosed at fair value in the financial statements on a recurring basis.

ASC 820 defines fair value as the price that would be received upon sale of an asset or paid upon transfer of a liability in an orderly transaction between market participants at the measurement date, and in the principal or most advantageous market for that asset or liability. The fair value should be calculated based on assumptions that market participants would use in pricing the asset or liability, not on assumptions specific to the entity.

In addition to defining fair value, ASC 820 expands fair value disclosure requirements and establishes a fair value hierarchy for valuation inputs. The hierarchy prioritizes the inputs into three levels: Level 1 inputs are observable inputs that reflect quoted prices for identical assets or liabilities in active markets. Level 2 inputs are observable inputs other than quoted prices in active markets for identical or similar assets or liabilities. Level 3 inputs are unobservable inputs that are significant to the measurement of fair value of the asset or liability.

#### 4. FEDERAL EXCISE TAXES

The Foundation is exempt from federal income taxes. In accordance with the applicable provisions of the Tax Reform Act of 1969 (“TRA 69”), the Foundation is subject to an excise tax on its net investment income, excluding unrealized gains, as defined in TRA 69. In addition, TRA 69 requires that certain minimum distributions be made in accordance with a specified formula. At March 31, 2011 and 2010, the Foundation had made the required minimum distributions. Excise taxes are provided at the effective rate expected to be paid.

GAAP requires Foundation management to evaluate tax positions taken by the Foundation and recognize a tax liability (or asset) if the Foundation has taken an uncertain position that more likely than not would not be sustained upon examination by the Internal Revenue Service. The Foundation administrator has analyzed the tax positions taken by the Foundation, and has concluded that as of March 31, 2011, there are no uncertain tax positions taken or expected to be taken that would require recognition of a liability (or asset) or disclosure in the financial statements. The Foundation is subject to routine audits by taxing jurisdictions; however, there are currently no audits for any tax periods in progress. The Foundation administrator believes it is no longer subject to excise tax examinations for years prior to 2006.

#### 5. RELATED-PARTY TRANSACTIONS

No contributions were received from McKesson Corporation during the years ended March 31, 2011 and 2010.

## **6. SUBSEQUENT EVENTS**

In September 2011, the Foundation received a cash contribution of \$10 million from McKesson Corporation.

The Foundation has evaluated subsequent events through December 21, 2011, the date that the financial statements were available for issuance.
