During 2010, Hands of Love received certain amounts that were designated by the donor for purposes that did not fall under our normal
gift classifications. Consistent with our purpose and policy, we submitted these amounts to our partners in Uganda and communicated the
donors request for how those funds would be used. The designation attached to these amounts dictated that they be used to pay off the
mortgage on the house owned by the president of Hands of Love, who resides in Uganda and oversees the charitable purpose. Some
contributions also went toward running a water line to the community in which his house is located.
The BOD of Hands of Love Found. has determined that each of these uses is consistent with advancing/supporting the mission of Hands of
Love. The Director and his family frequently host both staff and children from the Hands of Love orphanage. This is done in order to provide
community and a strong sense of family for the orphaned children. It is also a chance for the children and staff to be in a place where they
are served and ministered to As to the water line, the same reasons apply in that the water can be run to the Director's home.
Lastly, the new water line will also greatly reduce the effort and cost necessary to eventually run water to the orphanage itself as the
orphanage is in the same community.
