ARTICLE VI

The Village Club Foundation Restated Articles of Incorporation

The members of the corporation shall be all of the women who are active members of The Village Club, a Michigan non-profit corporation.

ARTICLE VII

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article II. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any subsequent Federal tax law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any subsequent Federal tax law).

ARTICLE VIII

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Trustees shall, after paying or making provision for the

payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, scientific, educational, or literary purposes, or for the prevention of cruelty to children or animals, as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any subsequent Federal tax law), as the Board of Trustees shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the circuit court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for charitable, scientific, educational, or literary purposes, or for the prevention of cruelty to children or animals, or to such organizations which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes, as that court shall determine.

ARTICLE IX

- A. This corporation shall distribute its income for each taxable year at such time and in such manner as not to become subject to the tax on undistributed income imposed by Section 4942 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent Federal tax law.
- B. This corporation shall not engage in any act of self-dealing as defined in Section 4941(d) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent Federal tax law.

- E. This corporation shall not make any taxable expenditures as defined in Section 4945(d) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent Federal tax law.

ARTICLE X

These Articles may be amended at any meeting of the members by the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members present in person or by proxy (if the Trustees have provided for proxy voting for that meeting), if a quorum is present and at least 20 days prior notice of the time, place and purpose of the meeting has been given.
