## A SHORT HISTORY OF THE OLD BOKOSHE CEMETERY ASSOCIATION

We have researched various old ledger books that are in possession of the Old Bokoshe Cemetery Association.

It appears from various entries that these ledger books were kept by Arthur & Vera Braun.

They are not in a month, day and year format but skip pages, and then come back several years later and fill in another year, thus it is hard to track the activities. They do list the Mother's Day Donations, who gave the donation and the amount donated.

Book One has entries beginning May 16, 1969, Book 2 continues with entries through 1984 and entered at various places are tidbits of information, which follows:

The Bokoshe Lions Club began taking donations to maintain the cemetery and set up the first account at Superior Federal Bank of Ft. Smith, Arkansas in 1966.

They then moved the account to Spiro State Bank of Spiro, Oklahoma, probably in 1969, because as of January 1, 1970, there was \$280.19 in the account.

The Bokoshe Lions Club added additional funds as needed, and at that time they paid \$100.00 per month from April thru November to have it mowed.

October 1971, they received a donation of \$5,000.00 and moved the account to Poteau State Bank of Poteau, Oklahoma and purchased the first C.D.

October 21, 1971 Larry Lucas drew up the paper work for a non profit Corporation named the "Old Bokoshe Cemetery Association", the cost was \$125.00

At this time The Bokoshe Lions Club remitted to the Old Bokoshe Cemetery Association what funds they had and the conversion was completed.
