## **WHO**

Summer scholarships are available on a competitive basis to Purdue students who have declared fine arts as their major. Acceptance to a summer program does not guarantee scholarship assistance nor does receipt of a scholarship guarantee full funding. Workshop costs may vary widely, therefore scholarship recipients may receive partial funding of the workshop costs and should anticipate identifying other sources of support in addition to the scholarship request.

## HOW

To apply for a summer scholarship students must complete and submit the attached application form, demonstrate acceptance or application to the summer program of their choice and participate in the Delta Phi Delta Fine Arts Awards Competition.

(Please note: summer programs often charge modest application fees, which are generally not refundable if you must cancel. Summer programs may also require partial tuition payment at the time of application, and this is usually refundable if you give them the required notice of cancellation. Carefully check these details before you apply and be aware of your cancellation deadlines if you will not be able to attend without scholarship assistance.)
