Intended uses of endowment funds

Agency endowment funds: Each year a portion of each agency endowment fund, currently around 5%, is paid or is available to be paid to the particular qualified organization.

Designated endowment funds: Each year a portion of each designated endowment fund, currently around 5%, is paid to the designated qualified organization or organizations, either as an unrestricted grant or for a designated qualified purpose.

Field-of-interest endowment funds: Each year a portion of each field-of-interest endowment fund, currently around 5%, is paid or is available to be paid to a qualified organization or organizations for a purpose in a designated field-of-interest (such as: health, education, etc.).

Operations endowment funds: Each year a portion of each operations endowment fund, currently around 5%, is transferred to the administrative fund to help pay for the costs of operating Mid-Nebraska Community Foundation.

Scholarship endowment funds: Each year a portion of each scholarship fund, currently around 5%, is paid in the form of a scholarship award to a U.S. postsecondary educational institution for the benefit of a qualified recipient.

Procedures for monitoring how grant funds are used

Procedures used by Mid-Nebraska Community Foundation to monitor the use of grant funds include the following:

- Ascertaining that recipients of grant funds are qualified to receive grant funds
- In cases of grants made for a particular purpose or project, verifying that recipients intend to spend grant funds on such particular purpose or project and further requesting final report information from recipients regarding actual use of grant funds for such purpose or project.
- Advising recipients that grants are made for the charitable purposes without any expectation of goods or services in return.
- Seeking information from public sources regarding the intended recipients of grants funds for any indication that an intended recipient may no longer need or warrant charitable grants, such as if the need has been fulfilled or if irregularities have been disclosed.

Conflict of interest policy and procedures

Conflict of interest policies are described in Article IV - Section 9 of MNCF By-Laws:

- (a) Significant involvement. In considering Foundation matters, Directors and other committee members will announce and disclose significant involvement with institutions or grantees under discussion. "Significant involvement" is defined as: (i) serving as an elected or appointed member of a governing board or major committee, (ii) receiving compensation as an employee or consultant, or (iii) being related to an individual grantee or to a staff member of a grantee institution.
- (b) Indirect Interest. A Director has an indirect interest in a transaction if another entity in which the Director has a material interest or in which the Director is a general partner is a party to the transaction, or another entity of which the Director is a director, officer, or trustee is a party to the transaction
- (c) Conflict of Interest. A conflict of interest exists when a Director has a direct or indirect interest in a transaction. A conflict of interest transaction is not voidable or the basis for imposing liability on the Director if the transaction was fair at the time it was entered into or is approved as set forth herein. A transaction in which a director has a conflict of interest may be approved in advance by the vote of the Board of Directors or a committee if the material facts of the transaction and the Director's interest are disclosed or known to the Board of committee, and the Directors approving the transaction in good faith reasonably believe that the transaction is fair to the Foundation.
- (d) Ratification. A conflict of interest transaction is authorized, approved, or ratified if it receives the affirmation vote of a majority of the Directors or committee members who have no direct interest in the transaction. A conflict of interest transaction may not be authorized, approved, or ratified by a single Director. If a majority of the Directors who have no direct or indirect interest in the transaction vote to authorize, approve, or ratify the transaction, a quorum is present for the purpose of taking action on the conflict of interest transaction. The presence of, or a vote cast by, a Director with a direct or indirect interest in the transaction does not affect the validity of any action taken by the Directors if the conflict of interest transaction is otherwise approved as set forth herein.

Reminder about conflicts or duality at meetings:

At virtually all MNCF Board of Director and Committee meetings, the agenda of the meeting includes a notice to participants that if the Board or Committee considers a matter that might constitute a conflict of interest or duality of interest involving a participant, it is the participant's obligation to disclose the facts of the situation as well as to abstain from voting and to refrain from attempting to influence the matter in those situations where a conflict of interest or duality of interest exists.

Abstentions are recorded in the minutes of the committee or Board of Directors.

Attachment 8 - Schedule O - 990 Part VI Line 15a

Procedures used in determining compensation of organization's Executive Director

The president of Mid-Nebraska Community Foundation appoints an executive evaluation committee made up of officers and directors, all of whom are independent.

The executive evaluation committee makes recommendations to the Board of Directors after considering:

- Position description
- Survey data about compensation of comparable positions at other community foundations in the U.S. and in the Midwest region
- Performance information
- Salary history
- Budget situation of the organization

The Board of Directors discusses recommendations and relevant information and then takes action on compensation of Executive Director. Recommendations of executive evaluation committee along with actions of Board of Directors are recorded in the minutes of the Board of Directors.
