- 3) ONCAC held directors 5 meetings (including the Humphrey Institute) in 2010-2011.
- 4) ONCAC welcomed two new children's advocacy centers to its membership Belmont and Tuscarawas Counties.
- 5)ONCAC had one children's advocacy center that went from associate to accredited membership (Warren County) and one that went from developing to associate level (Greene County).
- 6) ONCAC attended the National Children's Alliance Leadership Conference offering partial and full scholarships to 10 directors and the Ohio Initiative Coordinator.
- 7)ONCAC received approval for funding in the amount of \$215,000 (for calendar year 2011) from the National Children's Alliance. \$55,000 was for
