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History of Good Shepherd Montessori School

Good Shepherd Montesson School opened its doors for the first time in September 2002, but the origin of Good Shepherd is found in years of friendships, conversations, and graduate school discussions. Good Shepherd began among a group of passionate parents who came together with a common desire to create a school that would be faithful to Maria Montessori's original vision, that would foster peace in a socio-economically, racially, and ethnically diverse environment, and that would be committed to Sofia Cavalletti's concept of religious formation found in the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd. Her religious formation model was so vital to the mission of this new school that the parents chose to name the school after it, Good Shepherd Montessori School.

Central to the mission of Good Shepherd, then, is the religious potential of the child. Along with this, the parents desired a school that would serve the people whom Maria Montessori served when she began her school in the poor neighborhoods of Rome. Because of this, Good Shepherd is committed to bringing children of diverse economic and social backgrounds together in a learning environment of respect. Good Shepherd is committed to working with social entrepreneurs, parents, friends, and community leaders to secure matching scholarships for one-third of its student body.



We formed a Board of Directors, a nonprofit organization, found classroom space in the First Christian Church in downtown South Bend and opened with one lower elementary classroom and 16 children. Fueled by diligence and determination, Good Shepherd has continued to grow in 2003 we added a second lower elementary classroom and in 2004 opened our first upper elementary classroom.

2009 marked a moment in history for Good Shepherd We opened our Junior High classroom to serve children grades seven through eight. It is one of the few Montessori Junior Highs in the state of Indiana.

We also purchased the First Christian Church building that we originally leased. We are located in downtown South Bend. within 10 minutes of the

University of Notre Dame, and are on well-traveled Transpo bus routes We are currently pursuing joint accreditation with the Independent Schools Association of the Central States (ISACS) and the American Montessori Society (AMS)

Our first Primary Classroom will open in the fall of 2012, another milestone, as we celebrate our first ten years
