GRANTS AND CONTRIBUTIONS

PAID DURING THE YEAR

purposes of this Trust, the successor TRUSTEE named in ARTICLE XVIII of this instrument, including amendments, is authorized and empowered to pay from the income or principal of the trust property such amount, it any, for the benefit or account of the DONOR as he may, in his sole discretion deem necessary or advisable for the health, support, maintenance or satisfaction of legal obligations of the DONOR, and any net income not so distributed may be added to principal at any time. Any net income remaining at the DONOR'S death shall be added to principal at that time.

The DONOR in his capacity as original TRUSTEE shall be deemed incompetent for the purposes of this Agreement, including amendments, if:

- A. He shall be under legal disability determined by a Court of competent jurisdiction; or
- B. The successor TRUSTEE shall so determine, after receiving notice in writing from the wife or a blood relative of the DONOR/TRUSTEE of his apparent disability accompanied by the certificate of a physician graduated from an accredited school of medicine that the DONOR/TRUSTEE is physically or mentally incapable of managing investment and business property.

ARTICLE III:


DISPOSITION OF TRUST PROPERTY AFTER DONOR'S DEATH

Upon the death of the DONOR, the TRUSTEE shall deal with the Trust Estate, including any property that may be added thereto by reason of the death of the DONOR or by any other event, and whether proceeds of life insurance made payable to the TRUSTEE or under separate provisions of the DONOR'S will or otherwise as follows:

A. The TRUSTEE shall hold the sum of One Hundred Thousand (\$100,000.00)

Dollars, in a separate trust referred to as THE HELEN FAVA SCHOLARSHIP TRUST, to be administered to as follows:

1. The income shall be paid once each year equally to or for a boy and girl, senior students, at either Lynn Classical High School, Lynn English High School or Lynn Vocational Technical School, Lynn, Massachusetts, for college education, who in the TRUSTEE'S sole discretion shall be deserving of such award to be known as the "HELEN FAVA SCHOLARSHIP".



- D. The TRUSTEE shall divide the remaining principal and undistributed income into as many shares as there are living children of the DONOR and deceased children survived by issue.
- 1. The share set aside for the benefit of a then living child of the DONOR, shall be held as a separate trust as follows:

:1

- a. The TRUSTEE shall pay all the net income of the trust to or for such child and/or any one or more of his or her issue at least quarterly.
- b. Upon the death of such child of the DONOR, the TRUSTEE shall distribute the share of such deceased child of the DONOR as follows:
- i. While any living grandchild, as hereinbelow defined in ARTICLE III.D.3., of the DONOR is under twenty-four (24) years of age, the
