The university's governmental relations office has a full time director and a part time secretary. The vast majority of lobbying communications and direct contacts with legislators or legislative staff members emanates from this office. The university conveyed their position on various state and federal issues, miscellaneous economic development issues, energy, and environmental issues.
