FY2011 Cinereach LTD Area Descriptions

Cinereach Grants

During FY 2011 the Grants & Awards program had a biannual open call process to discover works-in-progress at all stages of production, from all over the world. Cinereach Ltd made 24 grants to film projects totaling \$707,496.59 in furtherance of its primary exempt purpose. These projects are led by first-time emerging or experienced filmmakers with a clear and compelling vision. Projects selected to receive grants towards completion can also rely on the Cinereach staff for beneficial guidance and introductions within the industry, as well as a public vote of confidence that can lead to other funders offering support.

Cinereach Productions

- *Forgiveness of Blood* (formerly *Untitled Albania Project*) is completed and will be theatrically released across the US in February and March of 2012. Cinereach got involved with the project April 2010.
- *The Road Ahead: The First Green Long March* is completed and has screened at various festivals, cultural and academic institutions. Currently our Creative Director is evaluating distribution opportunities. Cinereach got involved with the project in the spring of 2007.
- *Beasts of the Southern Wild* is in post-production premiered at the Sundance Film Festival in January 2012. Cinereach first got involved with the project in 2009.

Special Projects and Events

Sundance Event

On January 24, 2011, Cinereach hosted an event during the 2011 Sundance Film Festival to celebrate our supported films screening in competition. Four of the films received direct support through our Grants program, while the remaining two received support through our partnership with the Sundance Institute. Attendees included filmmakers, television broadcasters, film festival programmers, other funders and financiers from all over the country and beyond. The event's goal was to stimulate community engagement and offer a space for supported filmmakers to network with potential future collaborators or representatives of the industry who could help them achieve their exhibition, distribution and career-building goals.

Reach Out & The Reach Film Fellowship

"Reach Out" is the culminating event of The Reach Film Fellowship, a program of Cinereach's Special Projects. The fellowship is open to early-career filmmakers who have studied film at the undergraduate or graduate level, or are self-taught with the equivalent level of experience. To apply to The Reach Film Fellowship, young filmmakers submit a treatment or script of a short socially

aware film. Four filmmakers per year are selected to receive a \$5,000 grant, production support, and seven months of mentorship, career advising and industry exposure as they progress through the entire production and post-production process and prepare for submissions to festivals and distributors. Cinereach chose four Fellows who were each granted \$5,000 in production support, and paired them with mentors to offer assistance through the process. The fourth annual event, which was held April 13th 2011, commenced with a screening that showcased the work of the four Reach Film Fellows. A total of about 200 guests from the film industry and Cinereach's network were invited to attend the premiere of the Fellows' films and a reception to celebrate their achievements and introduce them to the industry.
