Grant proposals will not be considered unless they have been invited by the Trustees of the Foundation.

## GENERAL OVERVIEW

Like most donors, the Joseph and Licia Gimma Foundation has limited resources, and we will not be able to fund all the excellent programs seeking support.

## **GRANT PROPOSALS**

Grant proposals will not be considered unless they have been invited by the Trustees of the Foundation. Grant seekers should place a premium on brevity. Grant proposals must be in writing, and must include the following:

Organization Background: Description of the organization's history and mission; most recent annual report; annual budget; funding sources for overall operating expenses; documentation of tax-exempt status: 501(c)(3) letter from the Internal Revenue Service or evidence of de facto tax-exempt status as local, state or federal government entity: IRS Form 990 from the previous year.

**Project Purpose:** The project's overall objective and how the Joseph and Licia Gimma Foundation support will enable the organization to fulfill the objective.

Project Details: The project's key elements and time frame. Population to be served (demographic, geographic location, etc.).

**Problem(s)** Addressed: Specific needs addressed through project activities, including a description of how the needs are quantified.

Rationale: Discussion of why the Joseph and Licia Gimma Foundation should support the project. How the proposed project advances the philanthropic priorities of the Joseph and Licia Gimma Foundation.

Participants: Names and titles of persons who will oversee/implement project: names and titles of persons who will have fiscal authority over grant fund expenditures.

Linkage to Similar Initiatives: How the project links to similar efforts planned or under way, or to other programs dealing with complementary needs in the targeted area.

Budget: Detailed Budget. Names of other contributors and how much they will underwrite. How the project will be implemented and sustained if the Joseph and Licia Gimma Foundation does not fund the full amount requested. Plans for sustaining the project after the grant term expires.
