#### Note 1 Organization

Mobile Medical Care, Inc. (the "Organization") is a nonprofit charitable organization. The Organization provides comprehensive health care services for medically indigent and other selected low-income populations. The major sources of funding are contracts paid by government agencies as well as charitable contributions and grants from private and corporate sectors.

### Vans Other Clinics

The Organization provides medical care to the low-income and uninsured residents of Montgomery County, Maryland at little or no charge. The program is designed to provide access to quality health care to all residents age 18 and over who are unable to pay for these services. Patients are seen regardless of the ability to pay or whether or not there is a third-party reimbursement available. The majority of patients are between 30 and 65 years of age, however, all uninsured patients ages 18 and over are seen and their medical needs treated. Clinics are provided at various locations and in medical vans at scheduled times during each week and are staffed primarily by volunteer physicians and paid nurse practitioners, physicians' assistants and nurses. Patients are provided services on a walk-in or drop-in basis that removes the barriers of appointments and scheduling Clinic schedules tend to be at full capacity. The Organization continues to recruit new volunteers for both professional and support staff positions, to assist in the delivery of primary health care provided under this program.

#### Head Start

The Organization has entered into a contract with the Montgomery County Department of Health and Human Services to provide health management services to children 3 to 5 years old who are enrolled in the Head Start Program Through this contract, the Organization assesses the primary health care needs of children enrolled in the Head Start Program and refers them to Maryland Children's Health Insurance Program (MCHIP) and Care for Kids Once the children are accepted into these programs, the nurses link them with a program provider In the process of assessing the needs of children, the parents in need of primary care are identified and referred to the Organization, if they have no insurance Case management services are offered to all Head Start Program children and their families During the 2010-2011 the school year, the Organization provided services to children in 100 classes in about 60 Montgomery County Public Schools and community based centers

# Note 1 <u>Organization (continued)</u>

#### *UpCounty*

The Organization opened its newest, largest and most complete full-service clinic with support from Montgomery County, Shady Grove Adventist Hospital, Adventist Health Care, the State of Maryland, Kaiser Permanente and others This clinic contains six exam rooms, a patient reception area, a conference room, secure medical records storage, pharmacy, education space, and state of the art technology Equally important, it provides patients access to the complete Mobile Medical Care service inventory as well as providing initiatives such as those relating to behavioral health, women's health, and expanded services to the Asian community Open five and one-half days per week, it is anticipated that it will quickly grow to service almost forty percent of the agency's total caseload

#### Note 2 Expenditures

Of the total costs (including in-kind expenses) incurred for the year ended June 30, 2011, the Organization incurred 95 73% for program services, 2 40% for management and general operations, and 1 87% for fundraising

#### Note 3 Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

#### Basis of Accounting

The Organization maintains its records on the accrual basis of accounting

#### Accounts Receivable

Receivables are stated at amounts estimated by management to be the net realizable value. The Organization charges off accounts receivable when it becomes apparent based upon age or customer circumstances that amounts will not be collected.

### Note 3 <u>Summary of Significant Accounting Policies (continued)</u>

# Property and Equipment

Property and equipment are recorded at cost The cost of maintenance and repairs is recorded as an expense when incurred The Organization capitalizes major acquisitions with a cost of \$1,500 or greater and useful life of greater than one year. The Organization also capitalizes leasehold improvements that add to the life and value of the real property. Depreciation and amortization are calculated using the straight-line method over the estimated useful lives of the assets as follows.

Building and improvements 39 years
Leasehold improvements 10 years
Furniture and equipment 3-7 years
Vehicles 5-7 years

#### Revenue Recognition

Revenue from grants and contracts is recognized as related qualifying expenses are incurred Revenue is deferred when funds are received but not yet expended for the restricted purpose

Contributions are recognized as revenue when received or when an unconditional promise to give has been received and sufficient documentation exists. All contributions are considered to be available for unrestricted use unless specifically restricted by the donor Amounts received that are designated for future periods or restricted by the donor for specific purposes are reported as temporarily restricted or permanently restricted support that increases those net asset classes. When a donor restriction expires, that is, when a stipulated time restriction ends or a purpose restriction is accomplished, temporarily restricted net assets are reclassified to unrestricted net assets and reported in the Statement of Activities as net assets released from restrictions. Donor restricted contributions whose restrictions are met in the same reporting period are reported as unrestricted support.

Contributions of land, buildings and equipment are reported as unrestricted support unless explicit donor stipulations specify how the donated assets must be used Gifts of long-lived assets with explicit restrictions are reported as restricted support. Absent explicit donor stipulations, the Organization reports expirations of donor restrictions when the long-lived assets are placed into service

# Note 3 <u>Summary of Significant Accounting Policies (continued)</u>

#### **Donated Materials and Services**

The Organization uses in-kind contributions to support its programs. These donated services, materials and uses of facilities are reported as in-kind contributions on the Statement of Activities and Statement of Functional Expenses. Total donated medical professional services, other professional services, materials and use of facilities for the year ended June 30, 2011 were valued at \$5,524,553. In addition, over 100 individuals volunteered over 2,500 non-professional hours to perform a variety of tasks that assist the Organization. No amounts have been reflected in the financial statements for these non-professional services.

The Organization recognizes contributed services to the extent the services received create or enhance non-financial assets or require specialized skills that would be purchased if not provided by donation

#### Charity Care

The Organization provides care to clients who meet certain criteria either without charge or at amounts less than its established rates

#### Functional Allocation of Expenses

The costs of providing the various programs and other activities have been summarized on a functional basis in the accompanying Statement of Activities Accordingly, certain costs have been either directly charged to the programs and supporting services as incurred or allocated based on usage for items such as depreciation and salaries

#### **Income Taxes**

The Organization is exempt from federal income taxes on related income under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and is classified as other than a private foundation Income determined to be unrelated business income is taxable

#### Estimates

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America requires management to make certain estimates and assumptions that affect specific amounts and disclosures Accordingly, actual results could differ from those estimates

### **Subsequent Events**

For the year ended June 30, 2011, management has evaluated subsequent events for potential recognition and disclosure through December 28, 2011, the date of financial statement issuance, and believe there to be no further potential recognition or disclosure

The Organization maintains a line of credit with a maximum borrowing of \$500,000 Interest is payable monthly at the prime rate with a minimum rate of 4 25% The line is secured by the Organization's assets The line of credit is subject to annual review and is payable upon demand There was \$411,695 borrowed against the line as of June 30, 2011

#### Note 8 Operating Leases

In January 2008, the Organization entered into a five year lease for a medical office building. In addition, the Organization rents office equipment. #### Note 9 Defined Contribution Plan

The Organization sponsors a defined contribution plan covering substantially all of its employees. To be an eligible participant of the plan, employees must be 21 years of age and complete one month of service. Matching contributions to the plan are at the discretion of the Board of Directors. In addition, employees may make elective deferrals to the plan. During fiscal year 2011, the Organization did not make a matching contribution.

### Note 10 Prior Period Adjustment

Prior period adjustments were made to record land relating to a building purchased in prior years and to adjust the related depreciation, to correct the depreciation life of certain leasehold improvements and to record certain grant revenue and its related expense into fiscal year 2011, previously recorded in fiscal year 2010. The adjustments increase beginning unrestricted net assets by \$13,916 and decrease beginning temporarily restricted net assets by \$100,000.

#### Note 11 Concentrations

The Organization receives a substantial portion of revenue from local governments During fiscal year 2011, the Organization received approximately 49% of its revenue from the Montgomery County Government
