The mission of the Oklahoma City Community Foundation, a non-profit public charity, is to serve the charitable needs of its donors and the Oklahoma City area through the development and administration of endowment and other charitable funds with the goal of preserving capital and enhancing value.

Because of the diversity of interests of our donors, we serve charitable interests throughout the United States, but our main focus is the Oklahoma City metropolitan area.

The mission is fulfilled by pursuit of these goals:

- * To provide convenient, efficient and effective ways through which donors can contribute assets to charitable purposes.
- * To encourage donors to create funds that will benefit the community both now and in the future.
- * To advocate for the development of endowment funds and provide appropriate means by which permanent endowment funds can be built and wisely managed to provide long-term financial support.
- * To develop restricted and unrestricted community endowments which shall be used to develop, facilitate, coordinate and enhance services that meet the changing needs of the community.

The Oklahoma City Community Foundation has several different types of funds to accomplish its goals and missions, including Scholarship & Award funds, the Fund for OKC, Field of Interest funds, Charitable Organization Endowment funds (COEs) Donor-Advised funds and Affiliated funds.

Scholarship funds are established by individuals, corporations, nonprofit and civic groups to provide support for individuals who are seeking to improve themselves through higher education or additional training. For the year ended June 30, 2011, OCCF administered more than 100 permanent endowments which provided scholarships and awards to more than 500 individuals.

The Fund for OKC is a compilation of unrestricted funds that serve as the primary funding source for our Community Programs. This program helps nonprofits build and manage their endowments (Capacity Building), helps to improve the landscape of our community's public parks, medians, schools and neighborhoods (M.A. Boys Initiative), addresses illiteracy issues in our community (L.I.F.E) and provides scholarships (Trustee Scholarship Initiative).

The Field of Interest program provides a donor the opportunity to benefit a specific area of interest, type of organization, community issue or geographic area.

Our Charitable Organization Endowment (COE) program is the largest of its type in the US. As of June 30, 2011, the market value of these COE funds was \$153.6 million, and annual distributions were in excess of \$5.4 million.

Donor Advised funds provide a consolidated giving vehicle for donors, and can be either temporary or permanent funds. For the year ended June 30, 2011, advised fund assets were \$82.1 million, and grants exceed \$5.3 million.

Affiliated Funds (Type I Supporting Orgs) are large endowments that operate under a set of organizing documents and structure approved by the OCCF Board.

Their assets, liabilities, gifts, grants and activities are reported to the IRS separately from the OKC Community Foundation, but are managed day-to-day by the OKC Community Foundation. At June 30, 2011, total assets were \$333.7 million, and grants were in excess of \$13.2 million.
