Part III. Statement of Program Service Accomplishments
Eagle Wings Academy (EWA) exists to offer a Christ-centered, Biblically-based education to Urban Children. EWA equips and supports
students to reach their God-given potential and break free from the cycle of generational and spiritual poverty. EWA served 16 children from
substantially minority/poverty backgrounds (only 1 was Caucasian). The children ranged from Grades 2 to 9. EWA provided them with a
quality Christian education with a ratio of 1 teacher/volunteer per 3 students. The students were provided 172 days of quality education
that mostly coincided with the Syracuse City School District. The children had Bible lessons daily (including a weekly chapel service).
Once or twice a month, the children were able to go swimming at the local public pool. They were able to monthly hear Speakers talk about
their careers. Lunches were provided 3 times per week and other meals if necessary. The children continue to be assessed three times per
year to track their academic progress. The teenagers began personality profiles to determine their areas of interest and what they
need to do to reach their goals. EWA continues to receive positive responses from educators and parents from our third year of operation
(e.g.; a fifth grader who had flunked her previous year because of being verbally abused and refusing to attend school, has progressed
well academically at EWA and won third place in a local art contest). Our students continue to receive support and assistance to help
them overcome behavioral issues and to reach their full potential. Presently, the local Syracuse City School District has only 22.5% of the
children at Grade Level (i.e.; 77.5% of the children are below grade level). We are planning on a 5 week Summer School Program for the
Summer of 2011 and an After-School Program during the academic year 2011-2012.
