#### NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

### FOR THE YEAR ENDED JUNE 30, 2011

### NOTE 1 - SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES:

<u>Use of Estimates</u> – The preparation of financial statements in conformity with the accrual basis of accounting used for federal income tax reporting requires estimating some of the amounts reported. Actual amounts could differ from those estimates.

<u>Business Activity</u> - Beverly Rotary Club Foundation, Inc. was incorporated in Beverly, Massachusetts on Dec.18, 2002. It is a non-profit organization whose purpose is to perform social charitable activities to help build relationships that generate volunteer work and giving.

<u>Basis of Accounting</u> - The books of the organization are maintained, financial statements prepared, and tax returns filed using the accrual basis of accounting. Under this basis, certain revenues are recognized when received rather than when earned and certain expenses are recognized when paid rather than when incurred.

Depreciation of fixed assets is reported on the financial statements. Investments are recorded at cost rather than fair market value.

<u>Investments</u> - The investments are stated at cost. At June 30, 2011, the aggregate market was higher than cost by \$32,666.

<u>Income Taxes</u> - The organization is exempt from income taxation by a letter ruling issued by the Internal Revenue Service on June 13, 2003, under Section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954.

<u>Cash and Cash Equivalents</u> – For the purposes of the statement of cash flows, the Company considers cash and cash equivalents to be cash in operating bank accounts, savings accounts, and money market accounts.
