I, the undersigned Assistant Secretary of Essentia Health, a Minnesota nonprofit corporation organized pursuant to Chapter 317A of the Minnesota Statutes, do hereby certify that the Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation as set forth below were duly adopted by Essentia Health, pursuant to its Reserve Powers, on April 27, 2011. The effective date of such Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation shall be July 1, 2011.

AMENDED AND RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

ESSENTIA HEALTH FOUNDATION

(formerly known as Innovis Health Foundation)

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation is "Essentia Health Foundation."

ARTICLE II PURPOSES AND POWERS

This corporation is organized and shall be operated exclusively for charitable, educational scientific and religious purposes exclusively for the benefit of, to perform the functions of, or to carry out the purposes of the organizations set forth in Article X, and of the tax-exempt entities identified as supported organizations in their respective articles of incorporation, all of which are organizations described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code") and are not private foundations under Section 501(a)(1), Section 509(a)(2) or Section 509(a)(3) of the Code, all within the meaning of, and as contemplated and permitted by, Sections 170(c), 501(c)(3), 509(a)(3), and 2055(a) of the Code, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code and are not private foundations under Section 509(a) of the Code.

For such purposes, and not otherwise, this corporation shall have and may exercise all powers that are afforded to this corporation by the Minnesota Nonprofit Corporation Act and by any future laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto; provided, however, that this corporation shall not carry on any activity not permitted to be carried on by a corporation that is exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(a) of the Code as an organization described in Section 501(c)(3) and Section 509(a)(3) of the Code or by a corporation that is described in,

and contributions to which are deductible for federal income and estate tax purposes under, Sections 170(c) and 2055(a) of the Code.

All references in these Articles of Incorporation to a particular section of the Code shall include the corresponding provisions of any future federal tax law.

ARTICLE III PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES

No part of the net income or earnings of this corporation shall, directly or indirectly, inure to the benefit of any person having a personal and private interest in the activities of this corporation, but this corporation may pay reasonable compensation for services rendered to this corporation in furtherance of its purposes set forth in Article II hereof. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation and this corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distributing of statements), any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office. This corporation shall not lend money to, or guarantee the obligation of, any director or officer of this corporation.

ARTICLE IV REGISTERED OFFICE

The registered office of this corporation is located at 502 East Second Street, Duluth, Minnesota, 55805.

ARTICLE V MEMBERS

The Corporation shall have a sole corporate member, which shall be Essentia Health, a Minnesota nonprofit corporation (the "Member"). The Member shall have voting rights.

ARTICLE VI DIRECTORS

The management and direction of the business and affairs of this corporation shall be vested in a Board of Directors. The number, qualifications, terms of office, method of selection or election, powers, authority, and duties of the directors of this corporation, the time and place of their meetings, and such other provisions with respect to them as are not inconsistent with the express provisions of these Articles of Incorporation shall be as specified in or prescribed pursuant to the Bylaws of this corporation. Directors must be natural persons and a majority of the directors must be adults.

ARTICLE VII NO LIABILITY

Neither the directors, officers, committee members, employees or agents of this corporation shall be personally liable for the payment of any debts or obligations of this corporation of any nature whatsoever, nor shall any of the property of the directors, officers, committee members, employees or agents be subject to the payment of the debts or obligations of this corporation to any extent whatsoever.

ARTICLE VIII DISSOLUTION

This corporation may be dissolved in accordance with the laws of the State of Minnesota. In the event of the dissolution of this corporation any surplus property remaining after the payment of its debts shall be disposed of by transfer to the Member or its successor, to be held and used exclusively for charitable purposes, provided however, that if the Member or such successor is not then in existence or is not an organization described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, then such surplus property shall be disposed of by transfer to one or more corporations, associations, institutions, trusts, or foundations organized and operated for one or more of the purposes of this corporation, and described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, or to the State of

Minnesota or any political subdivision or agency thereof for exclusively public purposes, in such proportions as the Board of Directors of this corporation shall determine. Notwithstanding any provision herein to the contrary, nothing herein shall be construed to affect the disposition of property and assets held by this corporation upon trust or other condition, or subject to any executory or special limitation, and such property, upon dissolution of this corporation, shall be transferred in accordance with the trust, condition or limitation imposed with respect to it.

ARTICLE IX WRITTEN ACTION BY DIRECTORS

An action required or permitted to be taken at a meeting of the Board of Directors may be taken by a written action signed or consented to in an authenticated electronic communication, in one or more counterparts, signed by the number of directors that would be required to take the same action at a meeting of the Board of Directors at which all directors were present. All directors shall be notified immediately of the text and effective date of any such written action that is duly taken.

ARTICLE X SUPPORTED ORGANIZATIONS

This corporation's supported organizations shall be those organizations set forth herein provided that: (A) the organization is an organization described in Section 509(a)(1) or Section 509(a)(2) of the Code; and (B) the persons who control or manage this corporation have a sufficient commonality with the persons performing the same functions for such organization to ensure that this corporation (1) is responsive to such organization's needs; and (2) is an integral part of, or maintains a significant involvement in the operations of such organization.
