These donations are deposited and maintained in an account that is entirely separate from Pelotonia's operating account and 100% of these donations are transferred to The Ohio State University Foundation to be directed to cancer research at The Ohio State University Comprehensive Cancer Center and James Cancer Hospital Because Pelotonia's fundraising period for each of its events starts in December of one year and ends in November of the next year, the donations reported on the 990 in any particular fiscal year actually represent donations raised for two different Pelotonia events - i.e. donations for the event that was ongoing between July and November of a particular year and the donations for the event that was ongoing between December and June of the next year.
