Data Reports Registrations

Registered 1,347,474 manufacturers' data reports certifying that items were constructed and/or repaired in accordance with uniform safety standards, the ASME Boiler and Pressure Vessel Code and the National Board Inspection Code, copies of which are made available to National Board members to assist them in their respective duties of enforcement of boiler and pressure vessel safety rules and regulations within their respective jurisdictions. We also supplied 26,541 copies of previously-registered data reports to enable those items to be repaired and/or altered in accordance with uniform safety standards.

Testing, Reviewing, and Accrediting Quality Control Programs for Compliance with Safety Standards

We conducted 2,318 tests of safety relief valves, 1,104 reviews of quality control programs, and accredited 1,618 entities for the purpose of assuring compliance with the uniform safety standards of the ASME boiler and Pressure Vessel Code and/or the National Board Inspection Code. We provided 918 copies of the National Board Inspection Code, the safety standard for inspection and repair of boilers and pressure vessels.

Training and Commissioning of Inspectors in the Requirements of Safety Standards

We trained 1,500 students and commissioned 4,000 inspectors in the requirements of the ASME Boiler and Pressure Vessel Code and National Board Inspection Code in an effort to maintain uniform qualifications of inspectors and assurance of compliance with the uniform safety standards of the ASME Boiler and Pressure Vessel Code and the National Board Inspection Code.
