Hill has a Board of Governors, the members of which represent different segments of the floriculture industry-cut flower growers, greenhouse suppliers, importers, and service firms. This body reviews and approves research projects for funding submitted by universities worldwide. On a quarterly basis, Hill solicits contributions from former members of Roses Inc. through direct mail (Note as of June 30, 2010, Roses Inc. ceased office operations. Former members are being encouraged to make contributions to Hill.). In addition Hill provides a quarterly newsletter to the industry which includes progress reports on research funded and a contribution form. The newsletter is mailed to cut flower growers, greenhouse suppliers, wholesale organizations, and service firms. A web site is also provided to the industry and general public. Hill's 6/30/11 percentage of public support is 12.15%. Thus Hill is not publically supported Under the 33 1/3% support test.
