This includes all members of the Human Resources and Payroll departments, as well as the University's Controller, Assistant Controller and Director of Budget Services Annually, the Director of Human Resources and the Assistant Controller provide the Board with these individuals' compensation, as well as comparative data from similar universities. Once the data is reviewed by this Committee, annual compensation increases for these individuals is either approved or rejected. This rejection or approval is documented through a formal Board Resolution of the Board of Regents of Concordia University.
