#### AMENDED AND RESTATED BYLAWS

#### **OF**

#### **GROW QUAD CITIES FUND - ILLINOIS**

#### ARTICLE I Offices

The principal office of the Corporation in the State of Illinois shall be located in Rock Island County. The Corporation may have such other offices as the Board of Directors may designate or as the affairs of the Corporation may require from time to time.

The registered office of the Corporation may, but need not be, identical to the principal office in the State of Illinois, and the address of the registered office may be changed from time to time by the Board of Directors.

## ARTICLE II Purposes

The purposes of the Corporation shall be to advance the general welfare and prosperity of Rock Island County, Illinois and the surrounding Illinois Quad Cities area. The Corporation shall nonetheless have unlimited power to engage in and to do any lawful act concerning any or all lawful purposes for which corporations may be organized under the Illinois Not For Profit Corporation Act, 805 ILCS 105/101.01 et seq.

The Corporation shall be operated exclusively for those purposes allowed an exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 and its Regulations as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended.

The Corporation is not organized for profit and no part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall be distributed to, or inure to the benefit of, any director or officer of this Corporation, contributor or private individual, either during the existence of this Corporation or upon its dissolution. No substantial part of the activities of this Corporation shall be to carry on propaganda or otherwise attempt to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distributing of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any provisions of these bylaws, the Corporation shall not conduct or carry on any business not permitted to be conducted or carried on by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of said Code and Regulations as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended.

## ARTICLE III Membership

The sole member of the Corporation shall be Quad Cities Chamber of Commerce, Inc., a Delaware non stock corporation (the "Member").

### ARTICLE IV Board of Directors

- Section 1. <u>General Powers</u>. The business and affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by its Board of Directors (the "Board").
- Section 2. <u>Number, Tenure and Qualifications</u>. The Board shall be composed of not less than five (5) or more than nine (9) directors appointed by the Member. Each director shall serve for a term of one (1) year or until his or her successor is duly elected and qualified. Qualifications of the directors may be established by the Member.
- Section 3. <u>Regular Meetings</u>. An annual meeting of the Corporation shall be held without other notice than this Bylaw each year at such time and place as shall be designated by the Member at which meeting the directors shall be elected by the Member. The Board may provide, by resolution, the time and place, either within or without the State of Illinois, for the holding of additional regular meetings without other notice than such resolution.
- Section 4. <u>Special Meetings</u>. Special meetings may be called by or at the request of the President or the Member. The person or persons authorized to call special meetings of the Board may fix any place, either within or without the State of Illinois, as the place for holding any special meeting called by them.
- Section 5. <u>Notice</u>. Notice of any special meeting shall be given at least 24 hours previous thereto by written, electronic or oral notice delivered or telephoned to each director at his or her business address. Alternatively, notice may be given by mail, posted at least two (2) days previous to the meeting, addressed to each director's business address and with postage prepaid. Any director may waive notice of any meeting and the attendance of a director at a meeting shall constitute his or her waiver of notice thereof. Neither the business to be transacted at any meeting, nor the purpose thereof, need be specified in the notice or waiver of notice of such meeting.
- Section 6. Quorum. A majority of the members of the Board shall constitute a quorum.
- Section 7. <u>Presumption of Assent</u>. A director who is present at a meeting of the Board of Directors at which action on any matter is taken shall be presumed to have assented to the action taken unless his or her dissent shall be entered in the minutes of the meeting or unless he or she shall file his or her written dissent to such action with the person acting as the Secretary of the meeting before the adjournment thereof or shall forward such dissent by registered mail to

the Secretary of the Corporation immediately after the adjournment of the meeting. Such right to dissent shall not apply to a director who voted in favor of such action.

Section 8. <u>Informal Action by Directors</u>. Any action required to be taken at a meeting of the directors, or any other action which may be taken at a meeting of the directors, may be taken without a meeting if a consent in writing, setting forth the action so taken, shall be signed by all of the directors entitled to vote with respect to the subject matter thereof.

Section 9. <u>Vacancies</u>. Any vacancy occurring in the Board, including any vacancy created by reason of an increase in the number of directors, may be filled by the Member.

Section 10. <u>Powers</u>. The Board shall exercise all powers of the Corporation.

Section 11. <u>Committees</u>. The Board may appoint such committees as it deems desirable to assist it in its duties, which committees may, in the discretion of the Board, contain members who are not members of the Board.

### ARTICLE V Officers

Section 1. <u>Number</u>. The officers of the Corporation shall consist of a President and a Vice President, who shall be members of the Board, and a Secretary and a Treasurer who need not be members of the Board. The officers shall serve for a term of one (1) year or until their respective successors are duly elected and qualified.

Section 2. <u>Removal</u>. Any officer or agent elected or appointed by the Board may be removed by the Board or the Member whenever in either party's judgment the best interests of the Corporation would be served thereby.

Section 3. <u>Vacancies</u>. A vacancy in any office because of death, resignation, removal, disqualification or otherwise, may be filled by the Board for the unexpired portion of the term.

Section 4. <u>President</u>. The President shall be the principal officer of the Corporation and, subject to the control of the Board, shall in general supervise and control all of the affairs of the Corporation. He or she shall, when present, preside at all meetings of the Board. He or she may sign thereunto authorized by the Board, any deeds, mortgages, bonds, contracts, or other instruments which the Board has authorized to be executed, except in cases where the signing and execution thereof shall be expressly delegated by the Board or by these Bylaws to some other officer or agent of the Corporation, or shall be required by law to be otherwise signed or executed; and in general shall perform all duties incident to the office of President and such other duties as may be prescribed by the Board from time to time.

Section 5. The Vice President. In the absence of the President or in the event of

the death, inability or refusal of the President to act, the Vice President shall perform the duties of the President, and when so acting, shall have all the powers of and be subject to all the restrictions upon the President, and shall perform such other duties as from time to time may be assigned to him or her by the President or by the Board.

Section 6. <u>The Secretary</u>. The Secretary shall: (a) keep the minutes of the Member and the Board meetings in one or more books provided for that purpose; (b) see that all notices are duly given in accordance with the provisions of these Bylaws or as required by law; (c) be custodian of all corporate records; and (d) in general perform all duties incident to the office of Secretary and such other duties as from time to time may be assigned to him or her by the President or by the Board.

Section 7. The Treasurer. The Treasurer shall: (a) have charge and custody of and be responsible for all funds and securities of the Corporation; receive and give receipts for monies due and payable to the Corporation from any source whatsoever, and deposit all such monies in the name of the Corporation in such banks, trust companies or other depositaries as shall be selected in accordance with provisions of these Bylaws; and (b) in general perform all of the duties incident to the office of Treasurer and such other duties as from time to time may be assigned to him or her by the President or by the Board.

## ARTICLE VI Contracts, Loans, Checks and Deposits

- Section 1. <u>Contracts</u>. The Board may authorize any officer or officers, agent or agents to enter into any contract or execute and deliver any instrument in the name of and on behalf of the Corporation, and such authority may be general or confined to specific instances.
- Section 2. <u>Loans</u>. No loans shall be contracted on behalf of the Corporation and no evidences of indebtedness shall be issued in its name unless authorized by a resolution of the Board of Directors and approval by the Member. Such authority may be general or confined to specific instances.
- Section 3. <u>Checks, Drafts, etc.</u> All checks, drafts or other orders for the payment of money, notes or other evidences of indebtedness issued in the name of the Corporation, shall be signed by such officer or officers, agent or agents of the Corporation and in such manner as shall from time to time be determined by resolution of the Board.
- Section 4. <u>Deposits</u>. All funds of the Corporation not otherwise employed shall be deposited from time to time to the credit of the Corporation in such banks, trust companies or other depositaries as the Board may select.
- Section 5. <u>Fiscal Year</u>. The fiscal year of the Corporation shall terminate on June 30 of each year.

### ARTICLE VII Seal

The Corporation shall not have a corporate seal.

### ARTICLE VIII Dissolution

The Corporation may be voluntarily dissolved in the manner provided in the Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation or, in the absence of any such provision, as provided in the Illinois Not For Profit Corporation Act. In the event of liquidation or dissolution of the Corporation, whether voluntary or involuntary, the assets of the Corporation received from any source whatever, after the payment of all debts and obligations of the Corporation, shall be used or distributed, subject to the laws of the State of Illinois, exclusively for the purposes of the Corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, scientific or other non-profitable purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board shall determine, provided that such distribution is approved by the Member. Any of such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the District Court of the County in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

### ARTICLE IX Indemnification

The Corporation shall indemnify any present or former director, officer, employee, member or volunteer of this Corporation, and each such person who is serving or who has served, at the request of this Corporation, as a director, officer, partner, trustee, employee or agent of another corporation, partnership, joint venture, trust, other enterprise or employee benefit plan to the fullest extent possible against expenses, including attorneys' fees, judgments, fines, settlements and reasonable expenses, actually incurred by such person relating to his conduct as a director, officer, employee, member or volunteer of this Corporation or as a director, officer, partner, trustee, employee or agent of another corporation, partnership, joint venture, trust, other enterprise or employee benefit plan, except that the mandatory indemnification required by this sentence shall not apply (i) to a breach of the duty of loyalty to the Corporation, (ii) for acts or omissions not in good faith or which involve intentional misconduct or knowing violation of the law, or (iii) for a transaction from which such person derived an improper personal benefit.

#### ARTICLE X Amendments

These Bylaws may be altered, amended or repealed, and new Bylaws adopted by the affirmative vote of the Member.
