NOTE A - Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

<u>Nature of activities</u> - The **American Israel Education Fund** is a non-profit private foundation established to provide funds for educational and charitable institutions. The Organization's primary funding source is donor contributions.

<u>Basis of presentation</u> - These financial statements are prepared in conformity with the accounting practice prescribed by the Internal Revenue Service and the Office of the Attorney General of the State of Michigan The Organization has elected to use the cash basis of accounting, which is a comprehensive basis of accounting other than generally accepted accounting principles

Income tax status - The Organization qualifies as a tax-exempt private foundation under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and, therefore, has no provision for federal income taxes. The Organization is however liable for excise tax, that is, tax due on investment income

<u>Cash equivalents</u> - The Organization considers all short-term investments purchased with a maturity of three months or less to be cash equivalents. There were no cash equivalents at June 30, 2011.

<u>Use of estimates</u> - Management uses estimates and assumptions in preparing financial statements. These estimates and assumptions affect the reported amounts of assets and net assets, the disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities, and the reported revenues and expenses

<u>Date of management's review</u> - Subsequent events were evaluated through November 4, 2011 which is the date the financial statements were available to be issued

NOTE B - Concentration of Credit Risk

The Organization has concentrated its credit risk for cash by maintaining deposits in financial institutions which may at times exceed amounts covered by insurance provided by the U.S. Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation. The Organization has not experienced any losses in such accounts and believes it is not exposed to any significant credit risk to cash

NOTE C - Accounting for Uncertain Tax Positions

Effective January 1, 2009, the Company adopted the accounting standard regarding "Accounting for Uncertain Tax Positions". This accounting standard provides detailed guidance for financial statement recognition, measurement, and disclosure of uncertain tax positions recognized in the enterprise's financial statements. It requires an entity to recognize the financial statement impact of a tax position when it is more likely than not that the position will be sustained upon examination. The adoption of this standard had no material effect on the Company's financial position, results of operations or cash flows. The tax years of 2007 to 2009 remain subject to examination by the taxing authorities.
