1. Nature of Organization:

The mission of the West Virginia Child Advocacy Network is to support the development, growth and continuation of Child Advocacy Centers and multidisciplinary teams so that West Virginia communities can better serve children and families when concerns of child abuse arise.

2. Significant Accounting Policies:

For purposes of the statement of cash flows, cash includes amounts on deposit in the Organization's checking accounts. Management uses estimates and assumptions in preparing these financial statements in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles. Actual results could vary from the estimates that were used.

3. Grant Funding Requested and Receivable:

Grant money on most federal and state grants is received after documentation and invoices are presented for reimbursement. Grant Funding Requested and Receivable includes invoices submitted prior to the Organization's year-end.

4. Other Receivables:

Other receivables are for travel reimbursements in 2011 and in 2010, \$2,145 penalties and fines refunded by the Internal Revenue Service and \$1,250 in training fees due from the Development Disability Council (DDC).

5. Fixed Assets:

Computer equipment was purchased with WV Division of Criminal Justice Grant funding in 2009, 2010 and 2011. This equipment is recorded at cost and depreciated on a straight-line basis over the estimated useful life of the equipment, 3 years. Per the terms of the grant, the Organization must contact the WV Division of Justice & Community Services prior to sale, trade in or disposal of property in order to obtain disposition instructions.

6. Line of Credit:

West Virginia Child Advocacy Network opened a \$20,000 line of credit with First Century Bank on January 10, 2011, this replaced a \$10,000 line opened in June of 2009 which had expired. The interest rate is calculated based on The Wall Street Journal Prime Rate but never less than 6%. Monthly payments are required for the accrued interest and the Principal, principal plus any unpaid interest are due upon demand. The loan agreement expires on January 10, 2011. There was not balance due on the line of credit at June 30, 2010 or 2011.

7. Grants:

WV Child Advocacy Network received revenue from the following grants in 2010/2011.

Deferred grant revenue includes unexpended cash received from the above grants on a calendar year grant period which extends into the next fiscal years. Funds must be expended and reports submitted to the JAG and the National Children's Alliance to comply with terms of the grant. The Sisters of Saint Joseph grant is to support WVCAN's Mental Health Initiative.

8. Concentrations:

West Virginia Child Advocacy Network receives the majority of its funding from state and federal government programs.

9. Compensated Absences:

Regular, full-time employees may accumulate up to 15 days of vacation time which will be compensated upon termination of employment. Part-time employees may accumulate vacation hours based on their average work week. The liability for accrued vacation is \$3,462 at June 30, 2011 and was \$2,433 at June 30, 2010.

10. Lease Agreement:

The Organization leases furnished office space from Schoenbaum Family Enrichment Center Inc. The lease term is June 1, 2009 through June 30, 2012. Rent payments are \$7,200 for year 1, \$7,380 for year 2 and \$7,560 for year with a \$700 security deposit. Utilities, basic telephone service and access to front desk service, conference room, library and lounges are included in the lease as well as furniture and office fixtures. The lease includes an option to extend the lease for twelve months if final agreement is reached by December 31, 2011.

11. Excise Tax:

The Organization incurs excise tax on lobbying expenditures. The liability for fiscal year ended June 30, 2011 was \$909 on lobbying expense of \$4,545, for year-end 2011 the liability was \$1,086 on lobbying expense totaling \$5,429. Lobbying expense includes the applicable portion of the Executive Director's salary plus direct lobbying expenditures.

12. Related Parties:

The West Virginia Child Advocacy Network board of directors includes a representative from each of the Child Advocacy Centers which are members of the network. There are no financial transactions between board members and the organization.

13. Income Taxes:

West Virginia Child Advocacy Network is tax exempt under the Internal Revenue Code section 501(c)(3).

14. Subsequent Events:

Management has evaluated subsequent events through October 5, 2011, the date the financial statements were available to be issued.

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
