



The Edwin H. Eddy Family Foundation may lawfully make grants directly to institutions, organizations or individuals for the purpose of performing services to residents of the City of Duluth and surrounding areas for one or more of the following purposes:

1. Research educational work treatment and rehabilitation in the field of communicative disorders and related fields of neuro-pathology.
2. Financial assistance in testing, interpreting tests and treatment of individuals who have communication disorders with special consideration given to stuttering.
3. Scholarships to be given to students in the field of communicative disorders.
4. Funding of projects, programs and research that have application to helping individuals with communicative disorders.
5. Special consideration for funding to be given to institutions or organizations or faculties jointly sponsoring projects or programs.
6. Assistance to help in the rehabilitation of individuals with speech and/or hearing disorders.

In order to provide the Edwin H. Eddy Family Foundation Advisory Committee and the Edwin H. Eddy Family Foundation Trustees, the basis for making a determination of appropriateness and fundability, a grant application should provide the following information:

Identification of need to be met—definition of the problem.

Purpose, goals and objectives—the desired outcome of the project.

Method of achieving the goals and objectives—proposed activities.

Description of the applicant agency and its qualifications to conduct program including staff, responsibility for execution, experience and past record.

Description of project impact on Duluth area population to be served.

Assurance of nonduplication of existing programs.

Time frame of grant request and program operation.

Coordination of the program and funding with other organizations.

Budget per project—show cost to be covered by grant, other organizations or proposed grants and application share. Include past year's audit or final budget. Include budget detail.

Source of funds in budget for three years following Edwin H. Eddy grant.

Evaluation—how will you determine if program goals have been achieved, by whom will reports be filed.

The following documentation is required for all applications:

1. Copy of Articles of Incorporation.
2. List of officers and board of directors.
3. Proof of tax exempt status.
4. Letters of commitment from participating agencies.

Edwin H. Eddy Family Foundation is to be provided with eight copies of the grant proposal and cover letters and one copy each of Articles of Incorporation and proof of tax exempt status.

Upon approval of grant applications by the Edwin H. Eddy Family Foundation Trustees, the recipient will be required to enter into a grant agreement prior to the disbursement of funds evidencing the agreement of the recipient to all of the provisions of the grant agreement. Included in the agreement will be the outline of the specific programs that have been approved for funding, along with a detail of the specific dollar amounts for each part of the program, the dates and amounts of distributions, the repayment of any unused funds, the record of expenditures to be forwarded to the trustees, and reporting requirements to the Edwin H. Eddy Family Foundation.

GUIDELINES FOR EDWIN H. EDDY FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS

1. The award will be strictly scholarship and not traineeship.
2. Scholarships will be granted to college seniors and students in an accredited graduate program of Communication Disorders. Seniors will be defined as "a student who has completed the junior sequence". Grants are made only to full-time students.
3. Applicants must meet a minimum overall grade point average (currently 3.3) to qualify for a scholarship. This GPA minimum is subject to change.
4. Edwin H. Eddy recipients must agree to volunteer their time (once during the duration of the scholarship) to a local high school to help in the recruiting efforts in the Communication Disorders Program.
5. Amount of grants are as follows:
\$1,500 to senior level students for regular school year
\$4,000 to graduate level students
6. Priorities for granting scholarships shall be made in the following order:
 - A. Duluth area residents attending the University of Minnesota, Duluth.
 - B. Duluth area residents attending other accredited institutions.
 - C. Non-Duluth area students attending the University of Minnesota, Duluth.
7. Each applicant must provide the Edwin H. Eddy Foundation a completed application form and a certified copy of the most recent transcript(s) from present or previous institution(s) attended.
8. If an applicant meets the GPA requirements, upon successful completion of a personal interview with a member of the Scholarship Committee, a scholarship will be granted. The Committee's recommendation and the trustees' approval is based upon a determination that the applicant's interest and desire in the field has merit.
9. Interviews must be arranged by the applicant at the Department of Communication Sciences and Disorders; University of Minnesota, Duluth. Telephone number: (218) 726-7974. Renewal applicants will not be interviewed.
10. Applicants will be notified of awards within two weeks after interviews are completed.
11. The Edwin H. Eddy Foundation pays installment of the grant directly to the applicant as per schedule listed above.
12. To receive continued payments, a scholar must maintain the minimum GPA requirements each semester. Recipients not attending UMD must provide the Edwin H. Eddy Foundation a GPA report at the end of each semester.
