An Introduction to The Daily Iowan's Evaluation of Progress and Performance for Scholarship Recipients

FORM 990, SCHEDULE I, PART IV

The goal of this scholarship is to improve the quality of the paper by recruiting the best high school journalists and encouraging them to contribute to the paper throughout their college career. The scholarship allows recipients to work at the DI well before many of their peers while the paper benefits from having more experienced staffmembers in the newsroom.

Recipients should meet the following criteria while working at The Daily Invan::

1. Minimum GPA of 2.7 out of 4.33 after two semesters

2. Completion of at least nine credit hours per semester

3. Satisfactory newsroom performance

At the end of each semester, your newsroom performance will be evaluated by your immediate supervisor, i.e. a department editor and/or the editor. If you are the editor, your performance will be evaluated by the scholarship committee. A copy of the evaluation form, by which every DI staff member is reviewed, is included in this packet of information. The form rates your performance in the following areas: quality of work, meeting deadlines, attendance, willingness to complete assigned tasks, and ability and willingness to generate ideas for special projects.

If your performance is not satisfactory, you will be put on a one-semester probation. If the situation does not improve by the end of the probation period, the scholarship will be terminated and not re-instated. However, the termination will not preclude you from continuing to work in the newsroom at the discretion of the editor. In addition, you may opt to take a one-semester leave for personal or academic reasons while forfeiting the scholarship for that semester only.

As a scholarship student, your progress at the DI will also be closely monitored. The easlest way to measure your progress is by the position you hold. In this packet, you should find Expected Paths of Progress for all of the positions open to you when you begin working here: metro reporting, sports reporting, copy editing, photography, arts writing and editorial writing. If you already know which position you are interested in, it would be a good idea to talk to people on staff now about the position and what it requires. The Paths of Progress I have outlined are intended to give you some idea of what will be expected of you in those positions, although these requirements may change somewhat, depending on the current editor. If you change your mind about the track you have chosen after you start, you must discuss this with the current Editor-in-Chief. My advice would be to spend your first year or two as a metro, arts or sports writer, then maybe one semester on the copy desk or writing editorials, then apply for an editorial position in your field of Interest.

Most scholarship recipients will be required to work six to 10 hours per week at an entry-level position as freshmen, with the number of hours you work increasing somewhat each year. The editor, managing editor and sports editor are the only people who regularly work 40 hours a week, but many department editors work 20 to 35 hours a week. By your third or fourth year, it is highly probable that you will hold an editorial position. Although you are not required to hold an editorial position, the quality and amount of your work should improve consistently each year in order to keep the scholarship.

Working at the DI will teach you more about journalism than any class. Working here is like working on any newspaper — it involves a lot of time, commitment and hard work. As a reporter, you may be asked to write a story in just three hours. As a photographer, you may be asked to cover a protest in sub-zero temperatures at 7 a.m. And you'll be expected to do it with an agreeable smile. So be prepared to do what it takes to get the job done. Unlike high-school papers, we have a paper to put out every day, not next week or next month. Our 21,000 readers depend on it. You will learn to do your job quickly and accurately, and when it is all over, you will find yourself a much more marketable commodity in a very competitive field.
