TERESA TREAT STEARNS TRUST SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship shall be known as the Teresa Treat Stearns Scholarship.

The applicant must be a graduate of Webster City, Iowa High School and registered at a major accredited college, university, or vocational school.

The amount of the award will be determined each year dependent upon the income produced by the permanent scholarship fund. The awards can vary in the amount.

There will be multiple grants, with the Advisory Trustees making that determination annually after a review of the applications and the amount of funds available for distribution.

The awards shall be allocated by providing one-half of the scholarship for the first semester with the remaining one-half provided for the second semester. The Advisory Trustees may require evidence of successful completion of each semester. Should the individual receiving a scholarship fail to complete a semester, any or all of the money refunded shall be returned to the Teresa Treat Stearns Trust treasury. The Advisory Trustees shall be the sole determiner of that success or lack thereof.

The Advisory Trustees shall establish criteria for eligibility of students for recipients of these scholarships. They shall include such factors as demonstrated qualities of good citizenship; academic responsibility as correlated with capability; and the ability to succeed in post high school education at either vocational, technical college or university level. Eligibility shall be open to all who qualify, regardless of race, creed, sex or national origin.

Students, who are in the junior or senior year of college, or second year of a two-year vocational program, will be given priority. Students entering their sophomore year may be eligible for funds, if they are available. The Advisory Trustees may in special situations, provide funds for those in one-year vocational programs.

To apply for this scholarship in succeeding years, students should contact the First American Bank-Fort Dodge-Wealth Management Group. Students may reapply even if they did not receive this scholarship the first year of application.

This application must be turned into the First American Bank-Fort Dodge or Webster City by the deadline date. It must be filled out in full by the applicant himself/herself and be complete to be considered for the scholarship.
