plan, the corporate compliance office is responsible for monitoring risk areas and to ensure ongoing conformance with this policy.
Part VI Section 15b - Annually, the President of the Board of Directors appoints a Personnel Committee to conduct an evaluation of the
Executive Director's performance for the past year. Following this review the committee reviews the evaluation results with the Full Board
of Directors and submits a recommendation for the Executive Directors compensation for the coming year. Compensations for other key
employee's is established by the Executive Director and submitted to the Finance Committee as part of the annual budget. Once approved
by the Finance Committee, the annual budget is submitted to the Full Board of Directors for final review and approval.
Part VI Section C 19 - Lafayette House makes all governing documents, conflict of interest policy and financial statements available to
anyone by request. The Executive Director or designee will assist any person requesting access to these documents by appointment.
In addition, certain documents are regularly submitted to outside monitoring or oversight organizations including: minutes from the Board
of Director's meetings and monthly operating income statements are mailed monthly to our regional United Way Office; governing
documents are reviewed semi-annually by monitors from the Missouri Department of Mental Health in conjunction with their certification
review; policies including conflict of interest are distributed to all employees at their initial orientation session. Annual independent audits
and financial reports are filed with approximately 18 external funding entities (local, state, and national).
