FIF Local Chapters: FIFNC directly manages and operates six local FIF
chapters that served 625 families each year in 14 counties. Individuals
or families affected by developmental disability or traumatic brain
injury (TBI) (of one of the family members) apply to the chapter for
assistance. Chapter staff find local resources including private
businesses to pay for the need to the greatest extent possible. In
doing so, the need is met and public awareness is also increased. The
people assisted are also offered ways to assist other families if they
choose, through our Time Bank, Management Teams, or Lifetime
Connections Programs.

Lifeline Project: This program assists people (of any age) with developmental disabilities or TBI living in a county not currently supported by one of our FIF chapters that receive state and county funding. This program is supported by a small amount of state funding, and private donations and grants. It serves 45 counties.

Lifetime Connections: This program offers unique support and future planning services to people with all types of disabilities and their families through two core services, future planning education and support, and Personal Networks. These services provide an alternative or addition to traditional formal services. Lifetime Connections assists families to ensure quality of life for their loved ones with disabilities once the primary care provider (usually parents) is too elderly or deceased. Families are assisted to put in place their future

plans, including wills, special needs trusts, etc. and to develop

Personal Networks for current (and future) quality of life and peace of

mind. This program is currently funded through private pay (by lifetime

members) and through a federal grant specific to people with TBI with

an emphasis on returning veterans.

FIFNC Time Bank: This program connects community members through a system for sharing skills and services among the community membership.

FIFNC Time Bank is focused on people with developmental disabilities but also includes people without, and thus offers community integration and opportunities for serving/giving by people with disabilities.

FIFNC's role is to develop membership and coordinate communication among members.

Technical Assistance to all Chapters: FIF has a comprehensive

technical assistance component that strengthens the chapters and

provides long-term oversight to all 14 chapters. This is provided

through Site Visits, monthly conference calls and Webinars, Strategic

Planning sessions, an annual Summit for all Chapters, and Database

training on an ongoing basis.

In FY 2010 - 2011, our local Chapters and Lifeline Project together
served 650 families affected by disabilities and whose average annual
income was \$15,828 or 77% of federal poverty level. To serve these
families FIFNC stretched its public funding by leveraging \$.34 on the
dollar through contributions by local businesses and individuals.

Lifetime Connections program managed personal networks of 4 - 10
volunteers per person with disability, and met (38%) or made progress

Technical Assistance to Chapters included 12 monthly Chapters calls

(for providing training and information), one annual training event,

and 12 site visits to chapters by technical assistance staff who met

with chapter staff as well as management team members (volunteers who

year was to support the development of two completely new chapters and

to increase achievement ratings for FIFNC's Core Indicators of Chapter

Health.
