In addition to its rigorous curriculum and inclusive culture, the college is widely recognized for its excellence in fine arts and high levels of participation in robust athletic programs.

	The College of Adult & Professional Studies (CAPS) is committed to providing academic excellence to a diverse community of lifelong learners. Each adult degree completion program has been designed to create maximum student-to-faculty and student-to-student interaction via the cohort model. As of Fall 2011, 302 degree completion students were attending the university. We also offer the program for Adult College Education (PACE), for adults just beginning in this college. During fiscal year 2011, approximately 200 PACE students were served in Wichita, outreach facilities located in Lenexa, Kansas, and Topeka, Kansas. 420 graduates received diplomas in fiscal year 2011.

The cohort model is used for all programs in which groups of 12-20 graduate students progress together through their coursework toward the completion of their degrees.
