Housing Allowance: the President of the University is provided a \$30,000 housing allowance and a \$18,000 allowance for repairs to the house. The allowances are reflected in her W-2. Health or Social Club Dues: The University pays the President's dues to social clubs. The President uses these venues for business meetings and entertainment of donors.

Schedule J, Part I, Line 3 - The president's compensation contract is prepared using an independent consultant, compensation surveys and the Compensation Committee of the Board of Trustees. After approval by the Compensation Committee of the Board of Trustees the contract is presented to the Board of Trustees for their review and approval. The president's contract is reviewed annually.

Schedule J, Part II - Other reportable compensation includes housing allowance and maintenance totaling \$48,000 and group term life insurance and personal use of university automobile totaling \$6,330. It also includes deferred compensation totaling \$515,882 earned over the course of 13 years, but vested in 2010.

After approval by the Compensation Committee, the contract is presented to the Board of Trustees for their review and approval. The president's contract is reviewed annually. Line 15b: Vice president positions are handled as above. The vice president for academic affairs has a contract and all other vice presidents have appointment letters. Vice presidents are subject to an annual review of their performance as are all employees of the University. Form 990, Part VI, Section C, Line 19 - The University does not make its governing documents, conflict of interest policy and financial statements available to the public. If the University receives a request for any of these documents, senior management and the Board of Trustees determine if delivery of the requested documents is appropriate.
